



#### Dear Friends,

One can easily overlook a comment in St. Paul's Letter to Timothy from today's second reading. "Stir into flame the gift of God that you have received through the imposition of my hands," is a reference to Holy Orders. At an Ordination Mass, the consecrating bishop calls down the Holy Spirit as he places his hands on the head of the deacon or priest.

An important ministry of our archdiocese is the vocation office. The priests who staff that office help young men, and some who are not so young, discern whether Our Lord might be calling them to ministry. Father Jeremy and I are happy to answer any questions potential candidates may have and to put them in touch with the vocation office. Likewise, Deacon Dan is willing to do the same for anyone interested in exploring the diaconate.



Another way to learn more about the process, and to meet others who are also discerning, is to attend one of the two upcoming retreats organized by the vocation office:

# An Inspiring Morning with Justice Raya S. Dreben

Justice Dreben was born in Vienna, Austria, and emigrated to the United States with her parents when she was just 9 years old. A brilliant scholar, she graduated *magna cum laude* from Radcliffe College and *cum laude* from Harvard Law School before beginning her distinguished career in law. In 1979, Governor Michael Dukakis appointed her as Associate Justice of the Massachusetts Appeals Court, where she served faithfully for 32 years. Known as a trailblazer for women in the legal profession, she continued her work



with dedication and grace until her retirement at the age of 84.

# God Still Speaks Today—A Reflection on Psalm 95



"If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts." These words are both an invitation and a challenge. God speaks to us each day—in the stillness of prayer, in the beauty of creation, in the needs of those around us, and in the quiet movements of our own hearts. But how often do we allow the noise of the world, our worries, or our stubbornness to harden us against hearing Him?

This psalm reminds us that our God is not distant. He is our Creator, our Shepherd, the Rock of our salvation. He longs for us to come before Him with thanksgiving and joy, to bow down in humility, and to trust in His loving guidance. When we listen with open hearts, we begin to notice His voice calling us toward peace, mercy, forgiveness, and deeper faith.

Today, let us not turn away or close ourselves off. Instead, may we soften our hearts, remain attentive, and allow God's voice to shape our lives. If we listen closely, we will discover the Lord leading us gently, as a shepherd guides his flock, into the fullness of His love.

# Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary - October 7

The Rosary is more than a string of beads—it is a lifeline of prayer, a gentle rhythm that draws us closer to Jesus through the loving heart of His Mother. When we pray the Rosary, we are invited to walk with Mary as she guides us through the mysteries of Christ's life: His birth, His ministry, His suffering, His death, and His glorious resurrection.

Our Lady of the Rosary reminds us that prayer is powerful. History has shown us how the Rosary has brought peace in times of war, strength in times of trial, and consolation in times of sorrow. 


