





Saturday, October 11 was the feast day of St. Pope John XXIII. The date was chosen because October 11, 1962, was the day the Second Vatican Council opened. Come, and allow Christ's healing love to surround you and those you hold in your heart.


#### Autumn Seaside Festival-Nov. 1






St. Carlo Acutis - A Modern Witness of Gratitude and the Eucharist

This Sunday's Gospel tells of the Samaritan leper who, healed by Jesus, returned to give thanks. Gratitude is at the heart of faith—it recognizes that every good gift is from God.

St. Carlo Acutis, whose feast day is October 12 lived this truth with joyful simplicity. A modern teenager who loved soccer, video games, and computers, he used his gifts to glorify God, creating a website to share Eucharistic miracles with the world. His deep devotion to the Eucharist, "*my highway to heaven*," flowed from a heart full of thanksgiving for God's presence in his life.



Like the healed Samaritan, Carlo teaches us that gratitude is more than a feeling—it's a way of life. As we celebrate his feast day, may we, too, return to Jesus with thankful hearts and recognize Him, living and present in the Eucharist.

# An Inspiring Morning with Justice Raya S. Dreben

law. In 1979, Governor Michael Dukakis appointed her as Associate Justice of the Massachusetts Appeals Court, where she served faithfully for 32 years. Known as a trailblazer for women in the legal profession, she continued her work with dedication and grace until her retirement at the age of 84.


