






Final Week to Purchase Tickets!

An Inspiring Morning with Justice Raya S. Dreben

The Canton Catholic Women's Club was delighted to welcome The Honorable Associate Justice Raya S. Dreben on Wednesday, October 15, following the 9:00 AM Mass. The lower level of the church was filled with parishioners and guests eager to hear from this extraordinary woman whose life story is both inspiring and faith-filled.

Justice Dreben shared her remarkable journey—from her early years in Vienna, Austria, to her family's emigration to the United States, and her distinguished legal career. A graduate of both Radcliffe College and Harvard Law School, she went on to serve with great integrity and wisdom on the Massachusetts Appeals Court for 32 years after being appointed by Governor Michael Dukakis in 1979.

Guests were captivated by her humility, intellect, and wit as she reflected on her experiences as a pioneer for women in law and on the values that guided her throughout her life of service. The morning concluded with lively conversation, coffee, and delicious desserts, as guests expressed their gratitude for the opportunity to learn from Justice Dreben's example of perseverance, grace, and dedication.




