FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF THE LATER AN BASILICA Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16

Dear Friends,

St. Paul begins today's second reading, from his first Letter to the Corinthians, "Brothers and sisters: You are God's building." It encapsulates the concept that "church" can mean both a building and the People of God. Today's commemoration of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica reinforces the concept. First, it is a celebration of the Bishop of Rome's Cathedral. Secondly, it is celebrated throughout the Church Universal as acknowledgement of the Catholic Church's unity.

I think an objective observer of our parish community would be impressed by how we score on both the small "c" and Capital "C" fronts. Last weekend, for example, events at our vibrant and active community included Saturday evening's social and Sunday's Annual Mass of Remembrance. 

In this weekend's powerful Gospel, we witness



Jesus entering the temple and reacting with righteous anger at what had become a marketplace. The temple, meant to be a place of prayer, worship, and encounter with God, had been turned into a place of commerce and distraction. Jesus' actions remind us that God desires our hearts to be fully focused on


Him, not divided by worldly concerns.

"Zeal for your house will consume me," He says. These words reveal the intensity of Jesus' love for God and His desire that our worship be sincere and our hearts fully present. They also invite us to reflect on our own lives: Are there ways we allow distractions, busyness, or even selfish desires to crowd out our relationship with God?

Jesus also points to a greater reality—the temple of His Body, which would be raised from the dead. In Him, God's presence is made alive and accessible to all. Through His death and resurrection, we are invited into a living encounter with God that transforms our hearts and lives.

As we reflect on this Gospel, let us ask ourselves how we can honor God's presence in our own lives. May our hearts, like the temple, be a dwelling place for God, open to prayer, love, and service, free from what distracts us from His grace.

Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini: A Heart Without Borders

Feast Day: Thursday, November 13

This week we celebrate the feast of **Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini**, the first U.S. citizen to be canonized a saint. Born in Italy in 1850, Mother Cabrini devoted her life to serving immigrants, the poor, and the sick. With tireless faith and courage, she founded the **Missionary Sisters** of the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** and established schools, hospitals, and orphanages across the United States and beyond.

Mother Cabrini's life reminds us that holiness is not found in comfort, but in courage — in trusting God's call even when the task seems impossible. Her motto, "I can do all things in Him who strengthens me," guided her as she crossed oceans and cultures to bring Christ's love to those most in need.

A recent film "Cabrini", beautifully portrays her extraordinary story of faith, resilience, and compassion. The movie offers an inspiring look at a woman who refused to be limited by fear or circumstance — a true witness to the Gospel in action.

As we honor Saint Frances Cabrini, may we be inspired to live with the same missionary zeal and open hearts, seeing Christ in every person we meet.

Parish Seaside Dinner


