
Catholic Schools

Honoring the Gift of Life: Day of Prayer for the Unborn—January 22



On **January 22**, the Church in the United States observes the **Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children**, marking the anniversary of the 1973 Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion nationwide. While recent rulings have shifted the legal landscape, the protection of life remains a vital cause for prayer, penance, and advocacy.

We are called to reflect on the dignity of every human life, created in God's image, and to respond with love and support for mothers and families. At Mass, we give thanks to God for the gift of human life. Scripture reminds us that every person is created in God's image, lovingly knit together in the womb, and endowed with a dignity that must always be protected. The Gospel of the Visitation shows the joy that greets new life, as John the Baptist leaps in Elizabeth's womb at the presence of Jesus.

On this day, we offer prayer, fasting, and acts of charity. Let us also pray for healing for those affected by abortion and re-commit ourselves to supporting all expectant mothers with compassion and care.

Responsorial Psalm:**Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.**

There is a quiet courage in this week's psalm—a courage born not from strength or certainty, but from waiting. "I have waited, waited for the Lord..." The psalmist speaks for every heart that has ever cried out in fear, confusion, or longing. And then comes the tender response: God bends low. God stoops toward us. God listens.

This is the mystery of our faith: the Lord of heaven leans close enough to hear the trembling whisper of a single soul. And when God answers, something within us changes. A new song rises—not because our circumstances are suddenly perfect, but because we discover again that we are not alone.

The psalm reminds us that what God desires most is not our perfection or our performance, but our openness. "Ears open to obedience you gave me." God wants hearts willing to listen, to trust, to say with humility and hope, "Behold, I come." True discipleship begins not with grand gestures, but with the simple offering of ourselves—our

time, our attention, our willingness to follow where God leads.


To do God's will is not a burden; it is a delight written deep within us.

When we allow God's law of love to take root in our hearts, our lives become a quiet proclamation of God's goodness.

Like the psalmist, we find ourselves unable to keep silent. We speak justice. We live mercy. We become witnesses of God's faithfulness in the "vast assembly" of our daily lives.

This week, may we echo the refrain with sincerity and trust: Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will. May our waiting be patient, our listening be open, and our hearts be ready for the new song God longs to place within us.

Behold, the Lamb of God

This week's Gospel invites us into a moment of revelation—one that unfolds not with fanfare, but with quiet certainty. John the Baptist, long the voice crying out in the wilderness, sees Jesus approaching and speaks the words that have echoed through centuries: **“Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.”**

It's a declaration of awe, of recognition, of surrender. John doesn't claim credit or understanding. Twice he says, *“I did not know him.”* And yet, through obedience and trust, he becomes the one who points others to Christ. His mission was not to be the light, but to prepare hearts to receive it.

There's something deeply pastoral in John's humility. He listens. He watches. He allows God's plan to unfold beyond his own expectations. And when the Spirit descends like a dove and remains upon Jesus, John knows: ***This is the One. This is the Son of God.***

In our own lives, we may not always recognize Christ at first glance. We may feel uncertain, un-

worthy, or unsure of our role. But like John, we are invited to be witnesses—to prepare the way, to speak truth, to point others toward the Lamb of God who brings healing, mercy, and peace.

This Gospel reminds us that revelation often comes through quiet faithfulness. Through listening. Through waiting. Through the Spirit's gentle movement in our hearts.

May we, like John, have the courage to say: ***“Now I have seen and testified...”*** And may our lives reflect the grace of the One who comes to take away the sin of the world—not with judgment, but with love.

Even now, Christ walks toward us—quietly, steadily, lovingly. We may not always recognize Him at first, but the Spirit helps us see. And when we do, something within us shifts, softens, awakens.

May this be a week of renewed openness — a time to notice Christ approaching, to welcome the Spirit's gentle prompting, and to offer our own simple, faithful “yes.”


