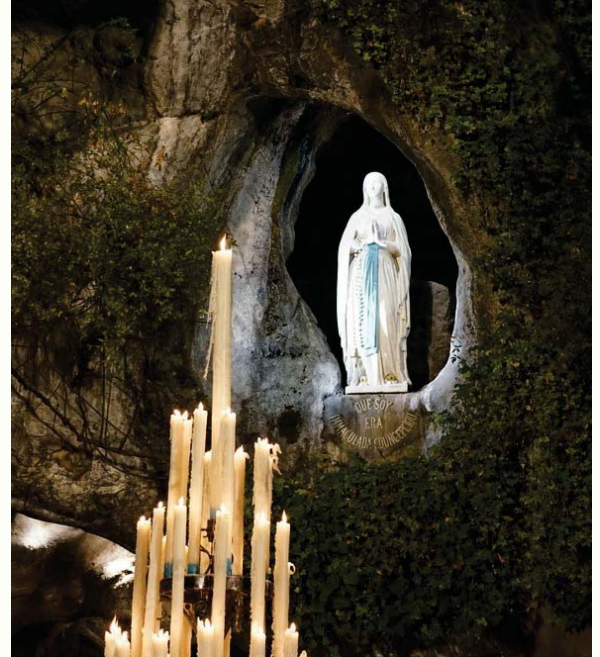
Dear Friends,

This **Wednesday, February 11**, on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, we also celebrate the 34th World Day of the Sick. This year, Pope Leo has called us to focus on the Gospel figure of the Good Samaritan, who demonstrates love by caring for the suffering man who fell in with robbers. It highlights a key dimension of love for one's neighbor: love must be expressed through concrete acts of closeness, by taking on the suffering of others — especially those who are ill, and often also vulnerable due to poverty, isolation, or loneliness.

As suggested by Pope John Paul II when he established this event, we are offering the Sacrament of the Sick at a Sunday Mass close to the feast day. In our case, it will take place this weekend at the **4:00 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday, February 7**. Worshippers may remain in their pews while the priests walk through the nave, anointing those who indicate they wish to receive the sacrament.

I will be away on retreat next week. I will be joining over fifty Boston priests at the annual retreat organized by Auxiliary Bishop Robert Hennessey. Be assured of my prayers for you and our parish.

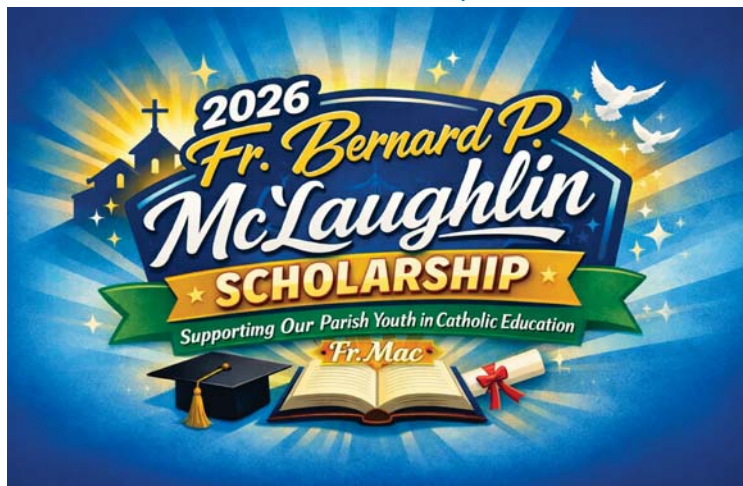
