OBJECTIVES

The project involved the design and installation of a bespoke wardrobe tailored to maximise storage but with visual appeal.

THE CHALLENGE

The existing wardrobe was poorly configured and failed to make effective use of the space. The client also wanted a cleaner, and more modern look with modern functionality.

OUR APPROACH

We began by carefully removing the existing wardrobe and clearing from the site. We then designed a 3D design which allowed the client to visualise the new wardrobe and make an informed decision, with full protection to floors, walls and surrounding areas during installation.

- White melamine interior.
- Four soft close drawers.
- Adjustable shelving.
- Hanging rail.
