OBJECTIVES

The project involved the design and installation of a large bespoke wardrobe, created to maximise storage capacity while maintaining a strong visual appeal.

THE CHALLENGE

The client wanted the new fitted furniture to seamlessly complement their existing pieces, with particular emphasis on achieving a close match to the pre-existing paintwork. The challenge was to create a cohesive, integrated look while maintaining a clean, modern aesthetic and ensuring the finished design worked harmoniously within the space.

OUR APPROACH

We began by carefully removing the existing wardrobe and clearing it from the site. We then designed a 3D design which allowed the client to visualise the new wardrobe and make an informed decision, with full protection to floors, walls and surrounding areas during installation.

THE SOLUTION

- Fully fitted design maximising space.
- Beautiful sleek aesthetic with slick nickel handles.
- Soft oak melamine interior.
- Three soft close drawers.
- Adjustable shelving.
- Hanging rail.

The finished wardrobe delivered significant improvement in storage space with a modern look which transformed an underperforming space.
