NEGRONI TIME

The Negroni was born in Florence, Italy, in 1919 and has since become one of the world's most celebrated classic cocktails.

Count Camillo Negroni, a flamboyant Italian nobleman known for his adventurous spirit and love of strong drinks was a regular at Caffè Casoni, a famous Florentine bar. His usual order was the Americano – a refreshing mix of Campari, sweet vermouth, and soda water. One evening, wanting something with a little more strength, Count Negroni asked bartender Fosco Scarselli to replace the soda water with gin, inspired by the cocktails he had discovered while travelling through London.

Scarselli obliged, garnishing the drink with an orange peel rather than the Americano's traditional lemon slice to distinguish the new creation. The combination of bitter Campari, aromatic vermouth, and botanical gin created a cocktail that was perfectly balanced – bold yet refined, bitter yet smooth.

The drink quickly gained popularity throughout Florence and beyond, eventually taking the Count's name: the Negroni.

More than a century later, the Negroni remains an icon of Italian aperitivo culture. Served before dinner to stimulate the appetite and encourage conversation, it represents the timeless elegance of Italy itself – simple ingredients, perfect balance, and a touch of style

WANGOLINA

Limestone Coast, SA

Italians are known for their generosity of spirit, big personalities, expressive gestures and that same generosity is reflected in their wines. These are wines of presence: bold in flavour, often rustic in tannin, and never shy.

They don't need coaxing; they meet you head-on, inviting you to slow down and settle in, ideally with food at the table.

In Australia, our wine culture has long been anchored by the classics—Shiraz, Cabernet, Riesling, Semillon, with Chardonnay finding its stride from the 1970s onward. But as both palate and climate evolve, so too does our lens. So-called "alternative" or "climate-appropriate" varieties are no longer fringe, they're becoming essential, offering growers and winemakers a far broader, more adaptable palette.

Italy, with over 600 indigenous grape varieties, provides a natural blueprint. These grapes are the product of vast climatic and geographical diversity, many evolved to retain acidity, structure, and flavour under heat and stress.

In an Australian context, warmer seasons, intense sunlight, and tightening water resources; they make increasing sense.

The result is fruit that holds balance naturally, often requiring a lighter touch in both vineyard and cellar. Then there's the stylistic range. At one end, bright, supple reds like Dolcetto and Barbera, wines built for immediacy and ease. Alongside them, whites such as Fiano and Arneis offer texture and freshness without sacrificing flavour.

At the other end, more brooding expressions like Montepulciano and Lagrein, bring depth, structure, and warmth.

What ties it all together is adaptability.

These are wines that meet the moment: versatile, characterful, and grounded. Unpretentious, yet full of life.

MASSETO

Bolgheri, Toscana, Italy

Masseto is best understood not as a wine, but as an idea, an alignment of elements, captured in a single glass.

*At its foundation lies **earth**. The famed blue clay of Masseto is rare, almost singular, a remnant of ancient seabeds that once shaped this corner of the Tuscan coast. Dense, mineral, and alive, it anchors the wine with depth and quiet authority.*

*Then comes **water**, felt rather than seen. The vineyard's closeness to the Tyrrhenian Sea tempers extremes, lending a gentle rhythm to the seasons. It is this maritime influence that brings poise to power, a natural calibration.*

***Air** follows, constant, moving, essential. Sea breezes thread through the vines, to the Tyrrhenian Sea tempers extremes lending a gentle rhythm to the season. It is maritime influence that brings poise to power, a natural calibration.*

*And then, of course, **fire**. The sun, generous and unrelenting, ripens Merlot to its fullest expression—dark fruit, opulence, and layered intensity. This is where Masseto finds its voice: rich, commanding, yet never without control.*

*But there is a fifth element, one that binds them all, **time**. Time in barrel, shaping texture and nuance. Time in bottle, softening edges and revealing complexity. And time at the table, where the wine is finally understood.*

Masseto is not simply made. It is composed; element by element, moment by moment, into something both powerful and profoundly complete.

Italian Chardonnay is an exploration exercise in balance, restraint, and terroir expression. The result is a spectrum of expressions built on the same core idea: citrus, orchard fruit, and saline lift, always guided by energy and clarity rather than excess.

In Piemonte, Chardonnay sits somewhere more discreet and contemplative, less about overt aromatics, more about finesse, tension, and quiet layering, often shaped by its proximity to Nebbiolo territory in spirit if not in style.

In Friuli, it gains texture and depth, often broader and more structured, with stone fruit and subtle lees influence adding weight without losing definition.

In Alto Adige, it is taut and alpine, high acidity, sharp citrus, and a pronounced mineral line driven by altitude and cool-climate precision.

FRENCH CHARDONNAY

Meursault, Puligny-Montrachet, and Montée de Tonnerre are a clean lesson in Chardonnay as site over style. Montée de Tonnerre is all tension-Chablis at its most chiselled. Chalky, saline, high-acid, and linear, with fruit firmly in support of structure. Puligny-Montrachet is precision and lift—citrus, white flowers, and fine mineral detail in a taut, architectural frame.

Meursault brings breadth—orchard fruit, hazelnut, and a subtle, rounded texture that adds generosity without losing balance. Three communes, three expressions: drive, finesse, and texture—Chardonnay shaped entirely by place

Following significant expansion in the 1980s, the region rose quickly on the global stage. A period of scrutiny in the wake of the Brunellopoli scandal ultimately led to stricter regulations and a renewed focus on quality and authenticity.

Today, Montalcino stands among Italy's finest regions, producing wines of depth, structure, and remarkable clarity of site, true expressions of Tuscan terroir.

ETNA ROSSO

From the slopes of Europe's largest active volcano, Mount Etna, emerges one of Italy's most compelling and rapidly ascending wine regions. This is viticulture forged in fire: a landscape continually reshaped by lava flows, volcanic ash, and wind, where vineyards feel less "planted" than etched into the mountain itself.

Often described as the "Burgundy of the Mediterranean," Etna combines precision and lift with a distinctly volcanic signature. Despite its southern latitude, altitude moderates the climate

The mountain's fractured geology has given rise to a mosaic of historic Contrade, each defined by subtle variations in soil, elevation, and exposure. Here, terroir is not an abstract concept but a living, shifting reality, written in ash, stone, and smoke, producing wines of striking transparency, tension, and place.

Hunter Valley, NSW

The Birthplace of Australian Wine

The Hunter Valley holds a unique and revered position in Australian wine history. Located just two hours north of Sydney, it is Australia’s oldest continuous wine-growing region, with vines first planted in the 1820s.

What makes the Hunter Valley truly remarkable is its ability to produce wines unlike anywhere else in the world. Despite its warm, humid climate, the region has become internationally renowned for its distinctive style of Semillon—a wine considered by many to be Australia’s most unique contribution to the world of fine wine.

Hunter Valley Semillon is typically released young, light-bodied and low in alcohol, displaying vibrant citrus and floral aromas. With age, it undergoes a remarkable transformation, developing complex notes of toast, honey and lanolin while retaining extraordinary freshness and longevity.

The region is also celebrated for its medium-bodied Shiraz, which offers elegance, savoury complexity and earthy character rather than sheer power. These wines reflect the Hunter’s distinctive terroir and showcase a style that is unmistakably Australian yet unlike the richer expressions found elsewhere in the country.

The Hunter Valley remains one of Australia’s most iconic wine regions—a living link to the country’s winemaking heritage and a benchmark for uniquely Australian wine styles.

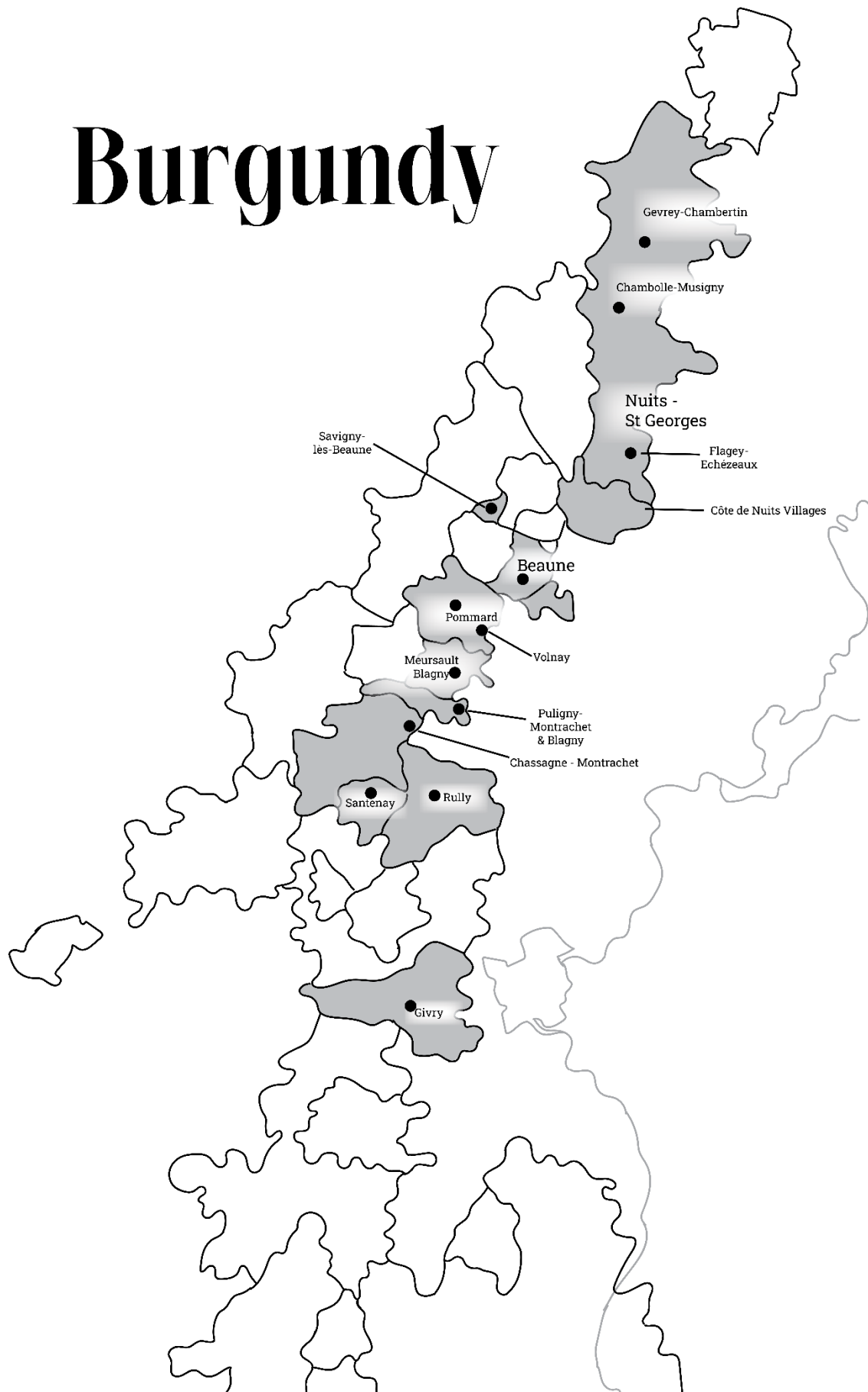

DOMAINE DUJAC

Burgundy, France

Domaine Dujac is one of those great Burgundy stories that starts a little differently, less inheritance, more obsession.

Jacques Seysses wasn't born into vineyards, he chose them. After cutting his teeth across some of Burgundy's top estates, he took a leap in 1968 and set up in Morey-Saint-Denis. No family Domaine, no safety net, just instinct, curiosity, and a serious love for great wine.

What followed was a slow burn. The vineyards expanded, the reputation grew, and the family evolved alongside it. Today, the next generation has taken the reins, keeping everything tight, thoughtful, and very true to its roots.

Out in the vines, it's all hands-on, meticulous, deliberate, and just the right amount of obsessive. Nothing rushed, nothing overlooked. In the cellar, it's about restraint: guiding rather than shaping, letting site and season speak clearly.

Under Jeremy Seysses, Domaine Dujac has found a new rhythm, one that still honours tradition, but isn't afraid to loosen the collar. There's precision, of course, but also personality. A fresh lens on what Burgundy can be today.

Think less hushed cellar, more quiet confidence, with a hip-hop soundtrack in the background. The approach is still meticulous, but there's a modern energy running through it: lighter touch, sharper detail, and a sense that great Burgundy doesn't have to feel old to be timeless. It's the same soul, just with a different beat.

With Nebbiolo, everything is defined by time and place. Its rewards are measured in patience and provenance. Demanding by nature, it requires meticulous care, nurTorinog and the finest vineyard sites—ideally hillside plots with optimal sun exposure—to reach its full expression.

It is among the most challenging grapes to grow, early budding, late ripening, and possessing an unusually long growing cycle, it is exposed to every climatic risk along the way. Yet it is precisely this difficulty that gives Nebbiolo its greatness—wines of depth, character, and enduring elegance.

LUCIANO SANDRONE

Barolo, Piemonte, Italy

Founded in 1978 in Piemonte, Sandrone has grown from a humble family garage project into one of Barolo's most respected modern estates. From his very first vintage, Luciano Sandrone brought a clear idea to life: serious work in the vineyard, precision in the cellar, and wines that speak clearly of their place, without the fuss.

This is very much a family story, but also one defined by obsession-level attention to detail in the vineyard and a refusal to cut corners. The result is Barolo with personality: pure, vibrant, finely structured, and always walking that fine line between power and elegance.

As part of the modernist movement that reshaped the region, Luciano Sandrone helped prove that Barolo could be both traditional in spirit and refreshingly contemporary in style, serious wines, made with serious intent, but never lacking a sense of joy in the glass.

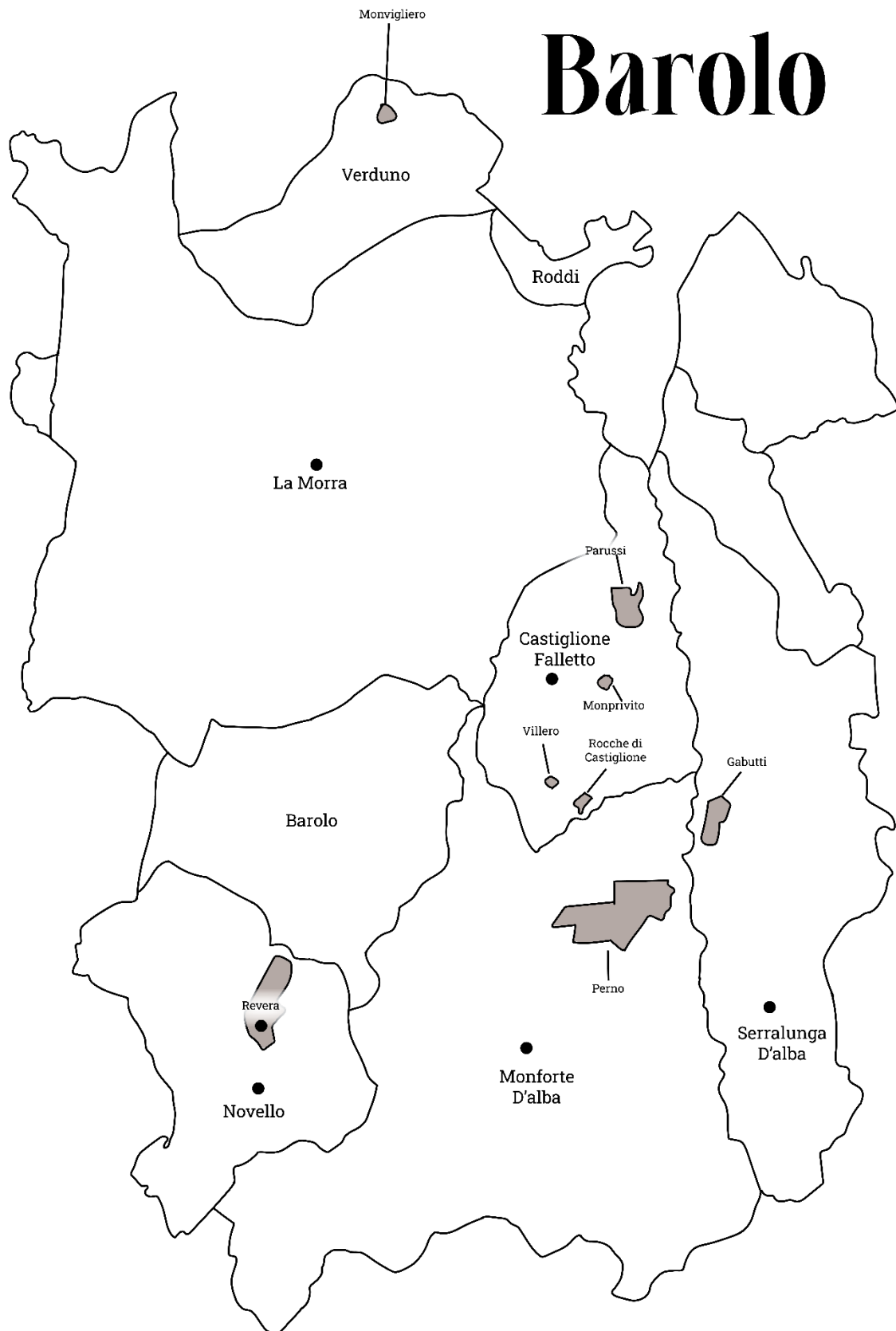

The King of Wines

There are few wines that inspire the same level of devotion as Barolo. Produced from the Nebbiolo grape in the hills surrounding the village of Barolo in Piedmont, this is a wine that rewards patience, conversation and reflection. It is often called "The King of Wines and the Wine of Kings," a title that speaks not only to its history but to the sense of occasion that comes with every bottle.

Barolo is a wine of contrasts. It possesses incredible power and structure, yet delivers remarkable elegance and perfume. In its youth, aromas of rose petals, red cherry and spice are framed by firm tannins and bright acidity. Given time, these wines evolve into something truly extraordinary, revealing layers of truffle, dried flowers, tobacco and earthy complexity that have made Barolo one of the world's most collectible wines.

What makes Barolo so fascinating is its ability to tell the story of place. The rolling hills of La Morra, Serralunga d'Alba, Monforte d'Alba and Castiglione Falletto each impart their own personality, creating wines that are unmistakably Barolo yet beautifully individual.

For many wine lovers, myself included, Barolo represents the pinnacle of Italian winemaking—a wine that combines tradition, craftsmanship and terroir in a way few regions can match. Powerful yet graceful, timeless yet constantly evolving, Barolo remains one of the most compelling and rewarding wines in the world.

BARBARESCO

While often and somewhat reductively, described as a "softer" counterpart to Barolo, this characterization overlooks the appellation's capacity for structure, precision, and longevity.

SANGIOVESE [Toscana]

In Australia, we've had a long and, at times, turbulent relationship with Sangiovese, Italy's most widely planted grape. From straw-wrapped fiasco bottles to rustic, inexpensive, "drink-now-don't-think" styles, many drinkers have ridden the full Sangiovese rollercoaster, falling in love one moment, only to swear it off the next, particularly when confronted with lesser expressions of Chianti.

A new generation of Sangiovese that is vibrant, precise, and deeply compelling, sourced from across Italy.

Often referred to as the "blood of Jupiter," Sangiovese is a variety of nuance and sensitivity. It responds acutely to terroir, arguably not unlike Pinot Noir, making provenance everything. Handled with care, Sangiovese rewards patience. Choose well the producer, parcel, and place and it offers wines of savoury complexity, bright acidity, and unmistakable character.

MARCHESI ANTINORI TIGNANELLO

Super Tuscan, Toscana, Italy

Born from one of Italy's most historic winemaking dynasties, Piero Antinori's Tignanello is nothing short of a revolution in a glass. Crafted from the same vineyards in the heart of Chianti Classico's Val di Pesa, these limestone-rich alberese soils and the estate's 400-meter elevation create wines of remarkable freshness, structure, and finesse.

First released in the 1970 vintage as a Chianti Classico Riserva, Tignanello quickly rewrote the rules of Tuscan wine. What began as a blend featuring Sangiovese and 20% Canaiolo evolved into the now-iconic marriage of Sangiovese with Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc — a bold move that helped define the Super Tuscan movement.

The 1971 vintage marked another turning point, with fruit sourced exclusively from the Tignanello vineyard in Tavolaia and the introduction of Cabernet Sauvignon into the blend. By 1975, white grapes had disappeared entirely, an almost rebellious act at the time. Even more radical was the decision to age Sangiovese in barrique, bringing unprecedented texture, polish, and depth to the variety.

Tignanello didn't just challenge tradition — it transformed Italian wine forever. Decade after decade, it continues to prove why true icons are never content to follow the rules.

SUPER TUSCANS

The divide between Old World and New is often framed as tradition versus innovation, but in practice it's far more unstable. Europe's great regions are built on history, regulation, and the authority of place; yet those same structures can just as easily become constraints.

Italy embodies that tension. A country defined by some of the most rigid appellation laws also gave rise to one of wine's most disruptive movements: the Super Tuscans. These wines didn't reject tradition, they challenged its limits. By stepping outside the rules, they forced a recalibration of the system itself, proving that quality and intent can outweigh prescription.

This is a nod to that insurgent spirit, wines grounded in place but never confined by it.

ETNA ROSSO

From the slopes of Europe's largest active volcano—Mount Etna—emerges one of Italy's most compelling and rapidly ascending wine regions. This is viticulture forged in fire: a landscape continually reshaped by lava flows, volcanic ash, and wind, where vineyards feel less "planted" than etched into the mountain itself. Often described as the "Burgundy of the Mediterranean," Etna combines precision and lift with a distinctly volcanic signature. Despite its southern latitude, altitude moderates the climate.

The mountain's fractured geology has given rise to a mosaic of historic Contrade, each defined by subtle variations in soil, elevation, and exposure. Here, terroir is not an abstract concept but a living, shifting reality—written in ash, stone, and smoke—producing wines of striking transparency, tension, and place.

CABERNET SHIRAZ

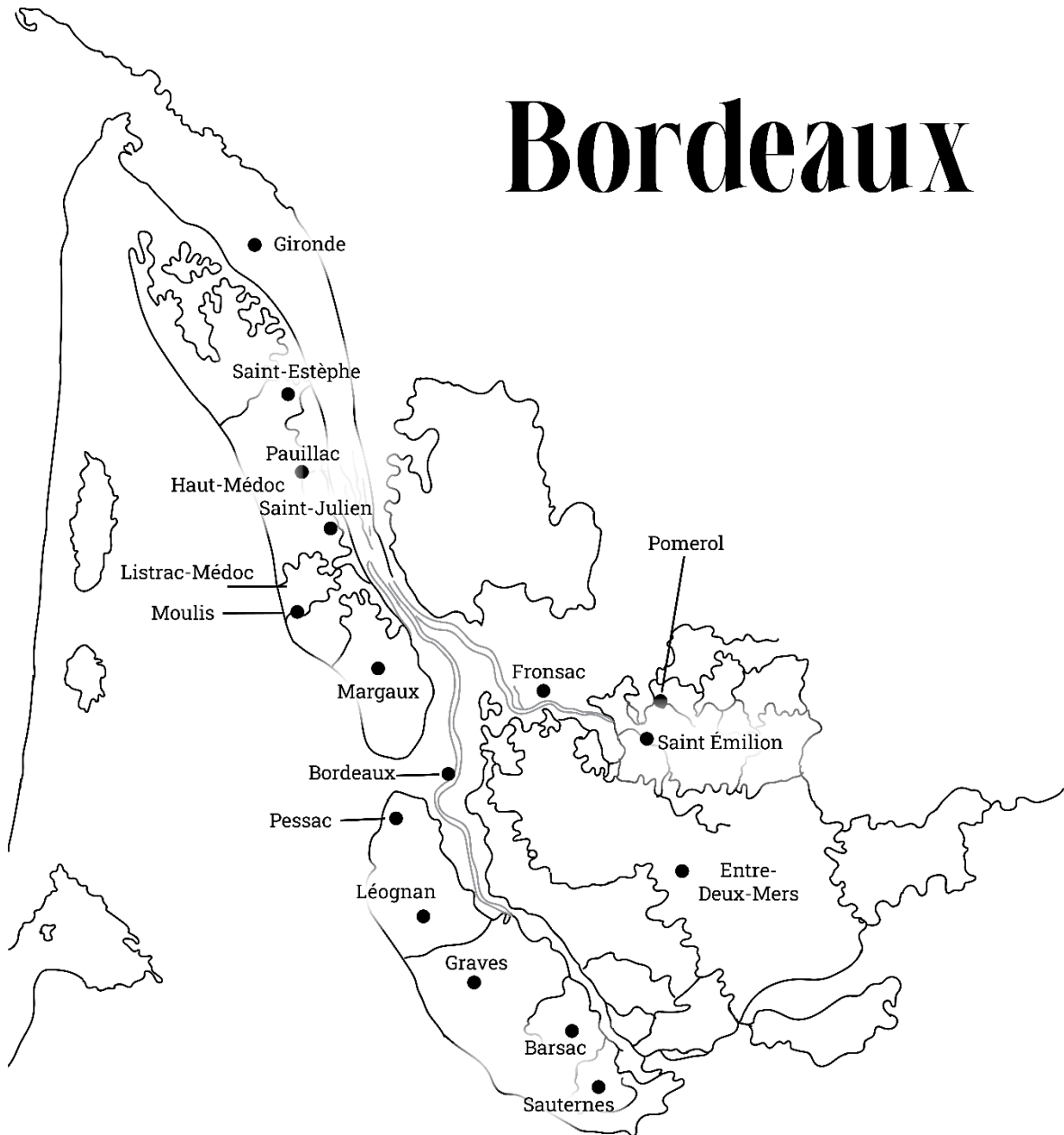
Australian winemaking heritage stands proudly on four distinctly national expressions: Hunter Valley Semillon, Rutherglen Muscat, Sparkling Shiraz, and the iconic Cabernet Shiraz blend. Each reflects regional identity and a broader story of adaptation, ingenuity, and stylistic confidence in a New World context.

The Cabernet Shiraz blend is a classic in Australian wine history. Its origins echo Old World precedent—most notably Bordeaux's historical practice of lifting structured clarets with Syrah (then Hermitage) to add depth, perfume, and mid-palate flesh. In Australia, however, this was reinterpreted rather than replicated. Cabernet Sauvignon brings structure and cassis line, while Shiraz contributes generosity, spice, and textural warmth.

What emerged is not imitation, but identity: a blending tradition shaped by Australian conditions and palate, now firmly established as one of the country's most recognisable signatures.
