Dear donors,

Since our last newsletter, we are happy to inform you that our orphans are doing well. Some of them have had to return to Syria because of the recent changes, but we continue to provide them with constant and attentive support, in coordination with our local partners. Despite the challenges, your solidarity allows these children to remain hopeful and to continue their journey with dignity.

A NEW SHIFT TOWARDS MEDICAL SUPPORT AND MENTAL HEALTH IN SYRIA

In view of the evolving situation in the region and the fragility of the Syrian healthcare system, Swiss-Group has chosen to focus its efforts more on supporting medical and mental health projects directly in Syria. The country faces many challenges: lack of infrastructure, shortage of medical equipment and lack of appropriate psychological care. However, we are convinced that sustainable accompaniment must include not only physical care, but also psychological support, to help children, orphans and their families overcome the trauma of war.

With this in mind, we have chosen to support the Rehabilitation Centre for People with Special Needs (SNR).



This Centre welcomes children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD), trisomy 21 and other special needs, 30 to 40% of whom are orphans, many of them sponsored by Swiss-Group.

The Centre has a multidisciplinary team of child psychologists, speech therapists, physiotherapists and special educators, who work every day to promote the development, autonomy and well-being of children. Our support aims to build their capacities, improve infrastructure and expand access to these essential services.

SUPPORT TO THE TEL ABIAD DIALYSIS CENTER

For several months now, Swiss-Group has also been supporting the **Tel Abiad dialysis Centre**, located in a highly volatile region of northern Syria, the only facility of its kind within a radius of 70 km, and it plays a vital role for dozens of patients suffering from kidney failure. Thanks to your donations, we have been able to ensure continuity of care and avoid its closure.

We are pleased to share that this year, many Swiss municipalities and foundations have provided us with valuable and encouraging support. Their trust strengthens our work and adds to your faithful generosity, without which none of this would be possible.
