Swiss-Group Celebrates 10 Years!

This year marks an important milestone: Swiss-Group is celebrating 10 years of humanitarian action! We would like to extend our heartfelt thanks to all our donators, volunteers, and partners who have made our work possible over the past decade.

Together, we have:

- Supported more than 10,000 families over the last 10 years
- Helped children continue their education all the way to university
- Provided ongoing care for children in remission from cancer
- Enabled life-changing surgeries for children thanks to your support
- Distributed food, blankets, medicines, clothing, coal, emergency tents after the earthquake, toys, bicycles, and so much more.

We would especially like to share the story of Rime, the very first orphan supported by Swiss-Group. After suffering burns over 75% of her body, she and her brothers received comprehensive medical care fully funded by Swiss-Group. Today, Rime has turned her own experience into a mission of service by working with burn survivors, helping others who have faced the same challenges. Her journey perfectly reflects the purpose of our work.



Our medical team is now based in Syria

Our medical team, who had previously been supporting our orphan programme from Türkiye, has now officially relocated to Syria to be closer to the families we assist.

Having a permanent presence on the ground allows us to strengthen our local network and provide even closer medical and social support to our beneficiaries.

The situation on the ground remains critical



The needs remain immense. Medical services are still severely limited, and many families continue to live in unsafe and inadequate housing. Our team works every day to improve access to healthcare and to help provide better living conditions for the most vulnerable.

There is, however, some encouraging news: schools are gradually reopening and returning to normal in several of the areas where we operate, allowing children to regain a sense of routine.
