Carrying the Burden of Love

Key Verse

"By His wounds, we are healed."
- Isaiah 53:5

Reflection:

In the rugged Himalayas, I watched a Sherpa carry a heavy load, a weight only he could bear. It reminded me of what Jesus did for us on the cross. He took the weight of our sins - a burden no one else could carry. Isaiah 53 says, *"He was pierced for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds, we are healed."* (Isaiah 53:5).

This is what we celebrate at Easter: the ultimate sacrifice of our Savior.

Today's Recitation

- How is Jesus calling you to carry the burdens of others?
- In what ways can you serve those around you this Easter, sharing both clean water and the living water of the Gospel?

Prayer

Jesus, thank You for bearing the weight of my sin on the cross. Help me to follow Your example and serve others with the same sacrificial love. Show me where I can carry a burden today, and use me to bring both physical relief and eternal hope. Amen.

Let water lead you to prayer
