MEET THE RECIPIENTS

The village is home to Yadav, Sah, and Chamar families, many of whom depend on daily labor for their livelihood and struggle to meet basic needs. Before the well was installed, about 20 families lacked reliable access to clean drinking water and could not afford to install their own well. They often depended on others for water, sometimes waiting long periods or being turned away. When water was unavailable nearby, they had to walk nearly one kilometer to collect it. The available water was also high in iron, causing an unpleasant taste, discoloration, and health concerns.

The situation became even more difficult during the rainy season, when roads turned muddy and water sources became contaminated or inaccessible.

Today, the new well is providing clean, safe water to approximately 20 households and benefits more than 50 additional people, including farmers, travelers, and nearby residents. Located near the main road, the well is easily accessible and has brought significant relief to the community.

The families are deeply grateful to Quenched for this support. This well has improved health, reduced daily burdens, and brought hope and encouragement to many people.

MEET THE CARETAKER

My name is Arvind Sah, and I am very grateful to Quenched for helping install this public well in our village. Before the well was installed, access to clean drinking water was a daily challenge for many families. Now, thanks to this 190-foot-deep well, the community has reliable access to safe drinking water.

The well was installed near the local temple, where many people gather each day. As a result, the entire community has witnessed the care and generosity shown through this project. In the past, many people held negative views of Christians. When we visited or shared about Jesus, we were often met with harsh words or avoidance because of misunderstandings.

Since the well was installed, attitudes have gradually changed. People have seen that Christians are willing to serve everyone equally, regardless of caste or religion. Today, we are welcomed into homes and have more opportunities to build relationships, pray with families, and share the gospel.

This well is doing more than providing clean water—it is helping build trust, open hearts, and strengthen relationships within the community. We are deeply thankful for this support and the positive impact it is having on people's lives.
