



## Jesus Calms The Storms

### Deep question

What storms feel overwhelming right now, and where do you need Jesus to speak peace?

### Scripture

Mark 4:35-41

*That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"*

### Teaching (from Video 3):

When the disciples faced a violent storm, they woke Jesus up, expecting Him to help them bail out water. Instead, He calmed the storm. Jesus still steps into storms today, especially for those walking miles for water or living in spiritual darkness. He brings peace, authority, and compassion in every storm.

### Family Activity

Turn off all lights for one minute. Sit quietly. Then turn on a lamp and talk about how Jesus brings peace into fear.

### Prayer

*Lord, speak peace into the storms around us and into the storms faced by children thirsting around the world.*

### A moment to reflect:

Ask God to make your family more aware of those longing for both safe water and hope.
