Jesus Calms The Storms

Deep question

How has your identity in Christ shaped your daily life, and how do you live out your new identity in Him?

Scripture

1 Corinthians 10:1-4

For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea. They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. They all ate the same spiritual food and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ

John 7:37-39

On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them." By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the Spirit had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

Teaching (from Video 4):

Water in the Bible represents both life and identity. Just as Israel became a nation when they passed through the waters, we are baptized into a new identity in Christ. Jesus, our living rock, provides us with living water that transforms us and calls us into His body, the Church. Baptism signifies our new identity—not just as individuals but as part of a larger, redeemed community.

Family Activity

Talk about the significance of baptism. Reflect on how being baptized into Christ shapes your identity as part of His body and mission. Turn off all lights for one minute. Sit quietly. Then turn on a lamp and talk about how Jesus brings peace into fear.

Prayer

Lord, thank You for the new life You give through baptism. Help us live out our identity in You, sharing Your love and living water with others. Amen.

A moment to reflect:

Ask God to reveal how your baptism shapes your life and how you can share His living water with those in need.
