Deep question

Scripture

John 3:5

Teaching (from Video 5):

Water represents life, renewal, and salvation. In the beginning, God's Spirit hovered over the waters, bringing order to chaos (Genesis 1:2). Jesus says we must be born of water and the Spirit to enter God's kingdom (John 3:5). Baptism symbolizes this new birth, marking us as part of God's body, the Church. It's a reminder that through water and the Spirit, God cleanses and renews us.
