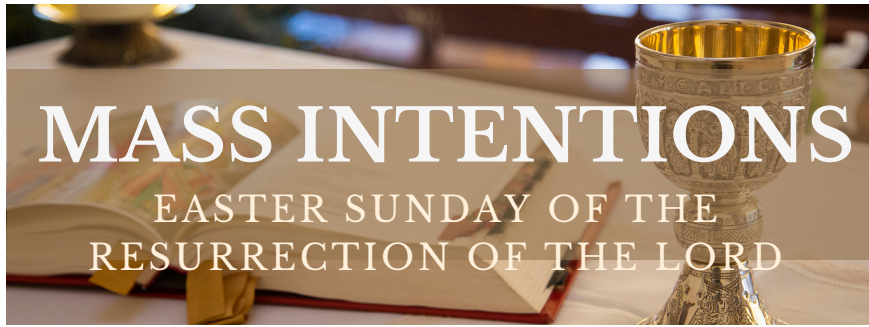

“Offering a Mass for someone, whether living or deceased, is considered the highest form of prayer in the Catholic faith, applying the infinite graces of Christ’s sacrifice for a specific need. It acts as a profound intercession for healing, comfort, special intentions, or the repose of a soul.”



You've heard the saying "Seeing is believing." Today's first reading seems to say just the opposite. You might think that when Jesus rose from the dead, everyone would see him. Yet Peter says that he was only visible to some of the disciples. Even they did not immediately see him. The first thing they saw was the empty tomb, with burial cloths lying on the ground. They may have thought that if his enemies had stolen Jesus' body, they would not have removed the burial cloths; touching a corpse would have made them unclean.

So it seems the empty tomb helped them to believe, and believing enabled them to see the Lord. The exception to this may be Thomas, who said he would not believe until he saw and touched Jesus' risen body. Yet when he does see the Lord, Jesus himself declares that believing is primary when he blesses those who have not seen but still believe (John 20:31).

What does this mean for us? Jesus seems to be hidden again. Yet we say that he is present in the sacraments; Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation show that the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit live in us. So perhaps we just need to believe in order to see him. Mother Teresa could do it. She said she was amazed at the love she felt when she saw Jesus in the poor and the dying people of Calcutta. Maybe we need to grow in faith so that we can see Jesus in the poor, the dying, the people who annoy us, even our enemies.

Han oído el dicho: "Ver para creer". La primera lectura de hoy parece decir todo lo contrario. Podríamos pensar que, cuando Jesús resucitó, todos lo verían. Sin embargo, Pedro dice que solo fue visible para algunos de los discípulos. Ni siquiera ellos lo vieron de inmediato. Lo primero que vieron fue la tumba vacía, con las telas funerarias en el suelo. Quizás pensaron que si sus enemigos hubieran robado el cuerpo de Jesús, no habrían quitado las telas funerarias, porque tocar un cadáver los habría vuelto impuros.

Así que parece que la tumba vacía los ayudó a creer, y la fe les permitió ver al Señor. La excepción podría ser Tomás, quien dijo que no creería hasta que viera y tocara el cuerpo resucitado de Jesús. Sin embargo, cuando ve al Señor, Jesús mismo declara que la fe es lo primordial al bendecir a quienes no han visto pero creen (Juan 20,31).

¿Qué significa esto para nosotros? Jesús parece estar oculto de nuevo. Sin embargo, decimos que está presente en los sacramentos; el bautismo, la Eucaristía y la confirmación muestran que el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo viven en nosotros. Así que quizás solo tenemos que creer para verlo. La Madre Teresa pudo hacerlo. Dijo que estaba asombrada del amor que sentía al ver a Jesús en los pobres y los moribundos de Calcuta. Quizás necesitamos crecer en la fe para poder ver a Jesús en los pobres, los moribundos, las personas que nos molestan, incluso en nuestros enemigos.

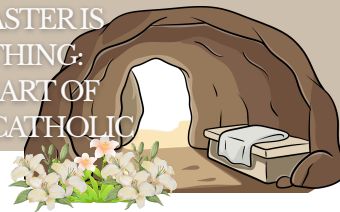

Here's something beautifully poetic—and very Catholic—in how God writes His story: Jesus is born in a cave and laid in swaddling clothes. The imagery there is no accident. Swaddling cloths weren't just cute baby wraps they were burial cloths, often kept for wrapping a body in death. Even as a newborn, Christ's mission was already pulsing underneath the surface.

**WHY EASTER IS EVERYTHING: THE HEART OF EVERY CATHOLIC**



Christmas and Easter aren't two separate stories. They are one divine arc—one movement of love that stretches from the crib to the cross. Christmas gives us the beginning: God with us, born into poverty, wrapped in cloth, and laid in a feeding trough. Easter gives us the end—and the new beginning: God still with us, but now risen in glory, leaving behind the burial cloths as signs of victory. At Christmas, angels sing "Glory to God in the highest." At Easter, we shout "Alleluia!" because that glory has conquered death. At Christmas, shepherds come to adore the Lamb. At Easter, Mary Magdalene runs from the tomb, the first to proclaim that the Lamb has risen. In Bethlehem, there was no room in the inn. On Calvary, there's no room in the grave.

Fast forward to Good Friday: Jesus is stripped of his garments, just as he was wrapped at birth. He's laid again in a cave this time, a tomb. But this time, there's no crying mother, no shepherds or stars. Only silence, sorrow... and waiting.

But that cave doesn't win. That tomb can't hold Him.

And suddenly, the story dicks into place: From the womb to the tomb, every thread is woven with meaning. His whole life was aimed at this crescendo this final movement where sin and death get turned upside down.

Everything about Christmas is fulfilled in Easter. The child born to save the world has done it. The wooden manger foreshadows the wooden cross. And the quiet night in Bethlehem whispers the promise of a new dawn outside the tomb.
