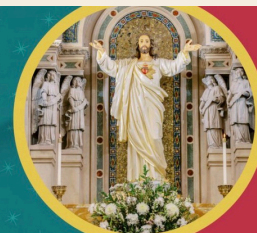

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Fifth Sunday of Easter

Of all the promises Jesus gave to his disciples, sometimes I find the one at the end of today's Gospel to be the most amazing of all. Jesus tells his disciples that they would do greater works than he did. What could be greater than walking on water, curing a blind man, raising the dead, or feeding five thousand people with only a few loaves of bread?

First, we have to ask what Jesus would think is greater. The apostles performed many miracles because of their faith in the Lord. They cured the sick, and Peter even brought a dead woman back to life (Acts 9:40). But even these signs are not greater than what Jesus did.

I think Jesus meant greater in the sense of the true work of a disciple. The disciples started right after Pentecost, when they received the power of the Holy Spirit. Peter went outside and began preaching to the people, resulting in three thousand people being baptized.

I wonder if we have that same kind of trust in Jesus that the apostles had. Maybe we have to start like they did. They talked about their experience of finding the empty tomb. They prayed, they discussed what had happened, and they looked for Jesus to appear to them. We can do those same things. We can talk about our faith with our families or in a parish discussion group. We can pray to be filled with the gifts of the Spirit and to see Jesus in other people. And we can look for God to act in our lives so that we can share God's love, which has been given to us, with those who do not know the Lord.

De todas las promesas que Jesús hizo a sus discípulos, a veces me parece que la que hizo al final del Evangelio de hoy es la más asombrosa de todas. Jesús les dice a sus discípulos que harían obras mayores que las que él hizo. ¿Qué podría ser mayor que caminar sobre el agua, curar a un ciego, resucitar a los muertos o alimentar a cinco mil personas con solo unos pocos panes? Primero, debemos preguntarnos qué consideraría Jesús como algo mayor. Los apóstoles realizaron muchos milagros gracias a su fe en el Señor. Curaron a los enfermos, e incluso Pedro resucitó a una mujer (Hechos 9,40). Pero ni siquiera estas señales son mayores que las que hizo Jesús.

Creo que Jesús se refería a algo mayor en el sentido de la verdadera labor de un discípulo. Los discípulos comenzaron justo después de Pentecostés, cuando recibieron el poder del Espíritu Santo. Pedro salió y comenzó a predicar a la gente, lo que resultó en el bautismo de tres mil personas.

Me pregunto si tenemos la misma confianza en Jesús que tenían los apóstoles. Quizás debamos empezar como ellos. Hablaron de su experiencia al encontrar la tumba vacía. Oraron y hablaron sobre lo que había sucedido y esperaron que Jesús se les apareciera. Nosotros podemos hacer lo mismo. Podemos hablar de nuestra fe con nuestras familias o en un grupo de discusión parroquial. Podemos orar para ser llenos de los dones del Espíritu y para ver a Jesús en los demás. Y podemos esperar que Dios actúe en nuestras vidas para que podamos compartir el amor de Dios, que nos ha sido dado, con los que no conocen al Señor.




WHAT DOES IHS MEAN?

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of El Paso Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026.

The Diocese of El Paso (“Diocese”) has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case. *In re: Diocese of El Paso (Bankr. W.D. Tx.)*. This notice is a short summary. For more detail, go to <https://cases.stretto.com/diocesefelpaso> or call (833) 345-0351.

Who Should File a Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below.¹ If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Claim?

You should file a claim using either Official Bankruptcy Form No. 410 (or a form substantially similar thereto) or the Abuse Proof of Claim Supplement Claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026. If you do not file a timely claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.
