SUNDAY REFLECTION

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Around holidays, people tend to look fondly back on past celebrations and romanticize old relationships. For some, remembering the past is the best part of their holiday. That is the image we get from the first reading as the apostles look up to heaven after the Ascension.

We too sometimes look at the great feasts of Christmas and Easter in that way. We may dwell on the beauty of the decorations, on the innocence of the baby Jesus, on the horror of his passion and death, or on the wonder of his resurrection. Then when the holy day is over, we go back to our normal routine. Perhaps we need an angel to chide us for "looking at the sky."

The angels were trying to tell the apostles two things. One was that Jesus would return as he left—in glory. This was not a time to say goodbye, but a time of hope; the Lord who had changed their lives so radically would change the world next.

The second thing the angels were telling them was to begin following Jesus' command to spread the Good News to all nations. Because of what the apostles accomplished, we are now Jesus' witnesses to the world. We too have the hope of seeing Jesus come in glory, even as we see him now with the eyes of faith.

Nosotros también a veces contemplamos las grandes fiestas de Navidad y Pascua de esa manera. Podemos reflexionar sobre la belleza de las decoraciones, sobre la inocencia del niño Jesús, sobre el horror de su pasión y muerte, o sobre la maravilla de su resurrección. Luego, cuando termina el día festivo, volvemos a nuestra rutina normal. Quizás necesitamos que un ángel nos reprenda por estar "mirando al cielo".

Los ángeles intentaban decirles a los apóstoles dos cosas. Una era que Jesús regresaría tal como se fue: en gloria. Este no era un momento para despedirse, sino un momento de esperanza; el Señor que había cambiado sus vidas tan radicalmente ahora cambiaría al mundo.

La segunda cosa que los ángeles les decían era que comenzaran a seguir el mandato de Jesús de difundir la Buena Nueva a todas las naciones. Gracias a lo que los apóstoles lograron, ahora somos testigos de Jesús ante el mundo. Nosotros también tenemos la esperanza de ver a Jesús venir en gloria, y mientras tanto lo vemos ahora con los ojos de la fe.

The Sanctuary Lamp

Pagar por una vela o veladora del Santísimo Sacramento es un acto de devoción católica, a menudo llamado "vela votiva", que simboliza una intención especial, oración o agradecimiento ante la presencia real de Cristo. Representa dejar el corazón unido a Dios, ofreciendo luz, fe y esperanza por una necesidad particular.

La vela encendida ante el Santísimo representa la luz de Cristo y es un signo visible de la oración de los fieles que permanece ante Él, incluso cuando la persona se retira. Se encienden para pedir favores, en agradecimiento por oraciones contestadas, o como señal de solidaridad y amor hacia alguien.

Más allá del costo material, es una ofrenda espiritual que simboliza la fe, la esperanza y el deseo de quemar el egoísmo o dificultades personales.

Es una forma de extender la oración y mantener la presencia espiritual en momentos de dificultad o gratitud.



Paying for a votive candle before the Blessed Sacrament is an act of Catholic devotion, often called a "votive candle," that symbolizes a special intention, prayer, or expression of gratitude before the Real Presence of Christ.

It represents uniting one's heart to God, offering light, faith, and hope for a particular need.

The candle lit before the Blessed Sacrament represents the light of Christ and is a visible sign of the prayer of the faithful that remains before Him, even after the person leaves. They are lit to ask for favors, in gratitude for answered prayers, or as a sign of solidarity and love for someone. Beyond the material cost, it is a spiritual offering that symbolizes faith, hope, and the desire to burn away selfishness or personal difficulties.

It is a way to extend prayer and maintain spiritual presence in times of difficulty or gratitude.

What is Eucharistic Adoration?

Eucharistic Adoration is a form of a private prayer. It is an opportunity to spend one on one time with Jesus.

What do you do at a Eucharistic Adoration? You can bring a religious book to read. You can say your rosary. You can say any prayer of your choice, remember prayer is a conversation with God. Simply be in the presence of Jesus. Be open and allow Jesus to transform you.

Jesus is inviting you to come and spend time with him. Perhaps fifteen minutes. Maybe thirty minutes. Or forty minutes. It could be any amount of time you can afford to spend with Jesus.

Jesus is inviting each of us to come to him. He says, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." (Matthew, 11:28).

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of El Paso Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026.

The Diocese of El Paso ("Diocese") has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case. *In re: Diocese of El Paso* (Bankr. W.D. Tx.). This notice is a short summary. For more detail, go to <https://cases.stretto.com/dioceseofelpaso> or call (833) 345-0351.

Who Should File a Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below.¹ If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Claim?

You should file a claim using either Official Bankruptcy Form No. 410 (or a form substantially similar thereto) or the Abuse Proof of Claim Supplement Claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026. If you do not file a timely claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.
