"Offering a Mass for someone, whether living or deceased, is considered the highest form of prayer in the Catholic faith, applying the infinite graces of Christ's sacrifice for a specific need. It acts as a profound intercession for healing, comfort, special intentions, or the repose of a soul."



In the readings on Pentecost Sunday, the Spirit is described as a driving wind and tongues of fire. Knowing that the Holy Spirit is a Person of the Trinity, we seem to be able to picture the Spirit only in terms of what the Spirit does. In our second reading, Paul tries to explain just that.

First, Paul says that we cannot know Jesus as Lord without the Spirit. The Spirit is the way Jesus is present today, so anyone who truly believes in Jesus is guided by the Spirit. Second, he acknowledges that the Spirit works in many ways. As examples, Paul mentions there are many different gifts and services in the church. He emphasizes that all these differences come from one and the same God.

When we think of the strength of the Church, we usually think of its unity, i.e., one baptism, one faith, one Lord. But we also draw strength from the diversity of gifts and services that people offer to God. So look at the gifts of those around you, and you may be able to see the Holy Spirit more clearly.

En las lecturas del domingo de Pentecostés, el Espíritu se describe como un viento torrencial y lenguas de fuego. Sabiendo que el Espíritu Santo es una Persona de la Trinidad, parece que sólo podemos imaginar al Espíritu de acuerdo a sus acciones. En nuestra segunda lectura, San Pablo intenta explicar precisamente eso.

Primero, San Pablo dice que no podemos conocer a Jesús como Señor sin el Espíritu. El Espíritu es la forma en que Jesús está presente hoy, así que cualquiera que realmente crea en Jesús es guiado por el Espíritu. Segundo, reconoce que el Espíritu obra de muchas formas. Como ejemplos, Pablo menciona que hay muchos dones y servicios diferentes en la iglesia. Resalta que todas estas diferencias provienen de un mismo Dios.

Cuando pensamos en la fuerza de la Iglesia, solemos pensar en su unidad, es decir, un solo bautismo, una sola fe, un solo Señor. Pero también sacamos fuerzas de la diversidad de dones y servicios que las personas ofrecen a Dios. Así que fíjate en los dones de los que te rodean, y capaz podrás ver el Espíritu Santo más claramente.

Hospitality is one of the most beautiful reflections of the heart of God. From the very beginning of our faith, we see a Lord who continually reaches out to His people, welcoming, embracing, listening, and transforming lives through love. Jesus Himself taught us that whenever we welcome others with sincerity and compassion, we are welcoming His very presence. For this reason, hospitality is not simply a ministry or a task within the parish; it is a spiritual mission and a concrete way of living the Gospel.

In a world where many people feel wounded, lonely, tired, or distant from faith, a genuine smile, a warm greeting, or a kind word of welcome can become the first step in helping someone encounter God again. Sometimes we think evangelization requires great actions, but the Lord also transforms hearts through simple gestures of love and closeness. A hospitable community can help a person move from feeling unnoticed to feeling truly part of God's family.

The hospitality ministry is a special invitation for all those who desire to serve with their hearts. It is not only about greeting people at the church doors; it is about becoming instruments of Christ's love. Every person who enters the church carries a different story: some come filled with joy, while others arrive carrying pain, worry, or spiritual need. Those who serve in hospitality have the privilege of showing them, from the very first moment, that there is a place for them in this community and that God never stops welcoming His children with love.

Joining the hospitality ministry also transforms our own spiritual lives. When we learn to welcome and serve others with humility, our hearts become more attentive to the voice of God. We discover that serving is not about losing time, but about encountering Christ in every person. Hospitality teaches us to live with gratitude, patience, compassion, and joy; it helps us grow as disciples and strengthens the unity of our parish community.

Today, the Lord continues to call generous hearts willing to open the doors of the Church and, above all, the doors of their hearts. Perhaps God is placing within you the desire to serve and help others feel loved and welcomed. Dare to answer that call. Your presence, your smile, and your willingness to serve may be exactly what someone needs to come closer to God again. Hospitality not only changes the lives of those who are welcomed; it also deeply transforms the life of the one who serves.

La hospitalidad es uno de los reflejos más hermosos del corazón de Dios. Desde el principio de nuestra fe, vemos a un Señor que siempre sale al encuentro de su pueblo, acogiendo, abrazando, escuchando y transformando vidas a través del amor. Jesús mismo nos enseñó que cada vez que recibimos a alguien con sinceridad y compasión, estamos recibiendo su propia presencia. Por eso, la hospitalidad no es solamente un ministerio o un servicio dentro de la parroquia; es una misión espiritual y una manera concreta de vivir el Evangelio.

En un mundo donde muchas personas viven heridas, solas, cansadas o alejadas de la fe, una sonrisa sincera, un saludo cálido o una palabra amable pueden convertirse en el primer paso para que alguien vuelva a encontrarse con Dios. Muchas veces pensamos que evangelizar requiere grandes acciones, pero el Señor también toca corazones a través de pequeños gestos de amor y cercanía. Una comunidad verdaderamente hospitalaria puede hacer que una persona pase de sentirse invisible a sentirse parte de la familia de Dios.

El ministerio de hospitalidad es una invitación especial para todos aquellos que desean servir con amor y alegría. No se trata solo de recibir personas en la puerta de la iglesia; se trata de ser instrumentos vivos del amor de Cristo. Cada persona que entra al templo trae consigo una historia distinta: algunos llegan llenos de esperanza, otros cargando tristeza, preocupaciones o necesidades espirituales. Quienes sirven en hospitalidad tienen el privilegio de mostrarles, desde el primer momento, que en esta comunidad hay un lugar para ellos y que Dios nunca deja de abrir sus brazos a sus hijos.

Incorporarse al ministerio de hospitalidad también transforma profundamente nuestra propia vida espiritual. Cuando aprendemos a servir y acoger a los demás con humildad, nuestro corazón se vuelve más sensible a la voz de Dios. Descubrimos que servir no es simplemente ayudar, sino encontrar con Cristo presente en cada persona. La hospitalidad nos enseña a vivir con gratitud, paciencia, compasión y alegría; nos ayuda a crecer como discípulos y fortalece la unidad y el amor dentro de nuestra comunidad parroquial.

Hoy el Señor sigue llamando corazones generosos dispuestos a abrir las puertas de la Iglesia y también las puertas de su corazón. Tal vez Dios está sembrando en ti el deseo de servir y de ayudar a otros a sentirse amados, acogidos y acompañados. Atrévete a responder a ese llamado. Tu presencia, tu sonrisa y tu disposición pueden ser exactamente lo que alguien necesita para acercarse nuevamente a Dios. La hospitalidad no solo transforma la vida de quien llega; también cambia profundamente la vida de quien sirve.

The Sanctuary Lamp

Pagar por una vela o veladora del Santísimo Sacramento es un acto de devoción católica, a menudo llamado "vela votiva", que simboliza una intención especial, oración o agradecimiento ante la presencia real de Cristo. Representa dejar el corazón unido a Dios, ofreciendo luz, fe y esperanza por una necesidad particular. La vela encendida ante el Santísimo representa la luz de Cristo y es un signo visible de la oración de los fieles que permanece ante Él, incluso cuando la persona se retira. Se encienden para pedir favores, en agradecimiento por oraciones contestadas, o como señal de solidaridad y amor hacia alguien. Más allá del costo material, es una ofrenda espiritual que simboliza la fe, la esperanza y el deseo de quemar el egoísmo o dificultades personales. Es una forma de extender la oración y mantener la presencia espiritual en momentos de dificultad o gratitud.

Paying for a votive candle before the Blessed Sacrament is an act of Catholic devotion, often called a "votive candle," that symbolizes a special intention, prayer, or expression of gratitude before the Real Presence of Christ. It represents uniting one's heart to God, offering light, faith, and hope for a particular need. The candle lit before the Blessed Sacrament represents the light of Christ and is a visible sign of the prayer of the faithful that remains before Him, even after the person leaves. They are lit to ask for favors, in gratitude for answered prayers, or as a sign of solidarity and love for someone. Beyond the material cost, it is a spiritual offering that symbolizes faith, hope, and the desire to burn away selfishness or personal difficulties. It is a way to extend prayer and maintain spiritual presence in times of difficulty or gratitude.

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of El Paso Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026.

The Diocese of El Paso ("Diocese") has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case, *In re: Diocese of El Paso* (Bankr. W.D. Tx.). Who Should File a Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below. If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Claim?

You should file a claim using either Official Bankruptcy Form No. 410 (or a form substantially similar thereto) or the Abuse Proof of Claim Supplement Claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026. If you do not file a timely claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.
