WHO DO YOU LOVE?

To be able to follow him, Jesus asks his disciples for total dedication. As an example, he tells us that to be worthy, we must love him more than we love our parents or children. If we see someone in our family straying from the faith, we try to help them return through our prayers, example, and encouragement.

Jesus then gives examples of three kinds of disciples. First come the prophets. These are people who have lived the faith and can teach others the wisdom they have learned. Second come the righteous, those who teach us by their example of a quiet life. Many good parents practice this kind of discipleship. Children may not listen to their parents' advice, but they still grow up with memories of how they lived. Finally come the "little ones." These people, like children, follow Jesus with great joy and love. They may be elderly or disabled.

When we respect and value them, we can see Jesus in them. And every time we can experience Jesus through another person, it is a wonderful reward for a disciple.

Para poder seguirlo Jesús pide a sus discípulos una dedicación total. Como ejemplo, nos dice que para ser dignos debemos amarlo más de lo que amamos a nuestros padres o hijos. Si vemos a alguien en nuestra familia desviarse de la fe, intentamos ayudarlo a regresar a través de nuestras oraciones, ejemplo y aliento.

Jesús luego da ejemplos de tres clases de discípulos. Primero vienen los profetas. Son las personas que han vivido la fe y pueden enseñar a otros la sabiduría que han aprendido. Segundo vienen los justos, los que nos enseñan con su ejemplo de una vida tranquila. Muchos padres buenos practican este tipo de discipulado. Es posible que los niños no escuchen los consejos de sus padres, pero aun así crecen con recuerdos de cómo vivieron. Por último vienen los "pequeños". Estas personas, como niños, siguen a Jesús con gran alegría y amor. Pueden ser ancianos o discapacitados.

Cuando los respetamos y valoramos, podemos ver a Jesús en ellos. Y cada vez que podemos experimentar a Jesús a través de otra persona es una maravillosa recompensa para un discípulo.

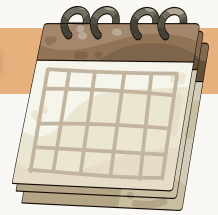

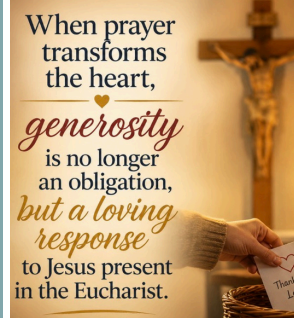

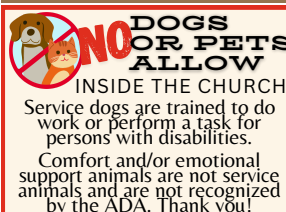

Public Notice – Action Required Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of El Paso Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026.

The Diocese of El Paso ("Diocese") has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case. *In re: Diocese of El Paso* (Bankr. W.D. Tx.). This notice is a short summary. For more detail, go to <https://cases.stretto.com/diocesefelpaso> or call (833) 345-0351.

Who Should File a Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below.* If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

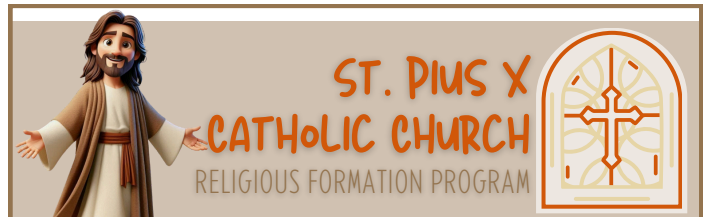
When and How Should I File a Claim?

You should file a claim using either Official Bankruptcy Form No. 410 (or a form substantially similar thereto) or the Abuse Proof of Claim Supplement Claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026. If you do not file a timely claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.
