THE Ascension

The ascension of Jesus refers to the events where Jesus Christ ascended to heaven after his resurrection, marking the completion of his earthly mission. This event is described in the Book of Acts, occurring 40 days after his resurrection, in the presence of his disciples. The ascension symbolizes Jesus' exaltation as his entry into supreme authority over creation, as well as the promise of the Holy Spirit's presence with believers. It is a significant event in Christian belief, representing not just a departure but the fulfillment of Jesus' mission and the establishment of his spiritual reign.

Sunday Reflection

The Gospel of John that is read on the Vigil of Pentecost says that “there was . . . no Spirit yet, because Jesus had not yet been glorified” (John 7:39). Obviously the Spirit is co-eternal with the Father and the Son, so John is trying to get our attention. He means that we could not experience the gifts of the Spirit until Jesus had died and risen from the dead. One way of looking at the Ascension is that Jesus can do much more for us in his glory than he could while on earth. How does this work? It happens in two steps. First, he sends the Holy Spirit to the disciples. Second, the disciples become his witnesses to all the nations. So let’s look at the first step.

While Jesus walked the earth, he chose to be limited in time and space, so that a few people could get to know and love him. But after his resurrection, he could be more effective by sending his Spirit to all believers. Because he is ascended into glory, he can live in all of us. And that leads to the second step.

Before his death, Jesus began to collect a group of followers. Some got to know him more deeply and became disciples. The rest of the followers were merely curious, or attracted by stories of miracles he had performed. But after his ascension the disciples began to experience Jesus in each other.

They could not help but be excited about that and spread that excitement to others. May we all experience that presence in the Spirit, seeing Jesus in ourselves and others.



El Evangelio de Juan que se lee en la Vigilia de Pentecostés dice que “pues aún no había venido el Espíritu, porque Jesús no había sido glorificado” (Juan 7,39). Obviamente, el Espíritu es coeterno con el Padre y el Hijo, por lo que Juan está tratando de llamar nuestra atención. Quiere decir que no podríamos experimentar los dones del Espíritu hasta que Jesús muriera y resucitara de entre los muertos. Una forma de ver la Ascensión es que Jesús puede hacer mucho más por nosotros en su gloria de lo que pudo mientras estuvo en la tierra.

¿Cómo funciona esto? Sucede en dos pasos. Primero, envía el Espíritu Santo a los discípulos. Segundo, los discípulos se convierten en sus testigos para todas las naciones. Así que veamos el primer paso.

Mientras Jesús caminaba por la tierra, eligió estar limitado en el tiempo y el espacio, para que unas cuantas personas pudieran conocerlo y amarlo. Pero después de su resurrección, pudo ser más efectivo enviando su Espíritu a todos los creyentes. Debido a que ascendió a la gloria, puede vivir dentro de todos nosotros. Y eso nos lleva al segundo paso.

Antes de su muerte, Jesús comenzó a reunir un grupo de seguidores. Algunos llegaron a conocerlo más profundamente y se convirtieron en discípulos. El resto de los seguidores simplemente tenían curiosidad o se sentían atraídos por las historias de milagros que había realizado. Pero después de su ascensión, los discípulos comenzaron a experimentar a Jesús en los demás. Se emocionaron mucho por eso y difundieron ese entusiasmo a los demás. Que todos experimentemos esa presencia del Espíritu, viendo a Jesús en nosotros mismos y en los demás.

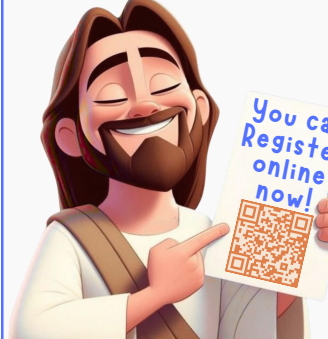
