



love, his miracles, his death and resurrection of the Holy Trinity, but knowing that God were not enough, lesus told us something about God that we never would have imagined: There are three Persons in one God. It is also something we cannot completely comprehend. So instead of trying to explain it, let's look at what it means for us believers.

One thing it shows is that God wants to be known by us. In ancient times, people would expect their gods to be mysterious and hidden. Many cultures thought that you could control a spirit or god if you knew its name. God sees us not as a threat, but as beloved children. Just as a couple falling in love wants to know everything about each other, so God wants to be known by those whom God loves. That leads to my second point.

The Trinity also shows us that "God is love" (1 John 4:16) because the three Persons are united in one God. God calls us to be united in love with God and with each other. Remember that God knows us perfectly and still loves us. Yet knowing our weaknesses and our sins does not hurt God's love for us. On the contrary, our weaknesses allow God to help us by forgiving sins, or inspiring someone to come to our assistance.

As if his own life, his teachings about God's We may not be able to grasp the full meaning shares this with faithful people helps us to love God even more.

Así que, en lugar de intentar explicarlo, veamos lo que significa para nosotros los creventes.

Una cosa que demuestra es que Dios quiere ser conocido por nosotros. En la antigüedad. la gente esperaba que sus dioses fueran misteriosos y ocultos. Muchas culturas pensaban que se podía controlar a un espíritu o dios si se conocía su nombre. Dios no nos ve como una amenaza, sino como hijos amados. Así como una pareja que se enamora quiere saber todo el uno del otro, así también Dios quiere ser conocido por los que ama. Esto me lleva al segundo punto.

La Trinidad también nos muestra que "Dios es amor" (1 Juan 4,16) porque las tres Personas están unidas en un solo Dios. Dios nos llama a estar unidos en amor con Dios y entre nosotros. Recordemos que Dios nos conoce perfectamente y aun así nos ama. Sin embargo, conocer nuestras debilidades y nuestros pecados no disminuye el amor de Dios por nosotros.

Al contrario, nuestras debilidades le permiten a Dios ayudarnos perdonando nuestros pecados o inspirando a alguien que venga a avudarnos. Puede que no seamos capaces de comprender el significado completo de la Santísima Trinidad, pero saber que Dios comparte esto con personas fieles nos ayuda a amarlo aún más.
