7 PASOS PARA RECIBIR LA SAGRADA COMUNIÓN EN LA MANO

1

Desinfecta tus manos.

2

Si lo deseas puedes hacer antes una genuflexión, una reverencia o arrodillarte.

3

Extiende tu mano izquierda (si eres diestro) o derecha (si eres zurdo) con la palma hacia arriba.

4

Coloca tu otra mano debajo. Decía san Juan Crisóstomo que eso era como prepararle un trono al Señor.

5

Te pondrán la Hostia sobre la palma. No te adelantes a intentar tomarla usando los dedos como pinzas.

6

Toma la Hostia con tus dedos índice y pulgar de la mano que está debajo, pon la otra mano bajo tu barbilla, como si fuera un platillo, para evitar que cualquier partícula caiga al suelo. Y consume la Hostia allí mismo, antes de volver a tu lugar.

7

Verifica que en la palma de tu mano y en tus dedos no hayan quedado partículas de la Hostia. Si las hay, consúmelas. Por ningún motivo te sacudas las manos como si te quitaras polvo.

Recuerda que aún el más mínimo fragmento es el Cuerpo de Cristo.

They looked as if they were going to a night club. I understand that on special occasions we want look our best, but we need to understand “what ” looks best on us especially when going to a church.

## Sunday Reflection

As if his own life, his teachings about God's love, his miracles, his death and resurrection were not enough, Jesus told us something about God that we never would have imagined: There are three Persons in one God. It is also something we cannot completely comprehend. So instead of trying to explain it, let's look at what it means for us believers.

One thing it shows is that God wants to be known by us. In ancient times, people would expect their gods to be mysterious and hidden. Many cultures thought that you could control a spirit or god if you knew its name. God sees us not as a threat, but as beloved children. Just as a couple falling in love wants to know everything about each other, so God wants to be known by those whom God loves. That leads to my second point.

The Trinity also shows us that “God is love” (1 John 4:16) because the three Persons are united in one God. God calls us to be united in love with God and with each other. Remember that God knows us perfectly and still loves us. Yet knowing our weaknesses and our sins does not hurt God's love for us. On the contrary, our weaknesses allow God to help us by forgiving sins, or inspiring someone to come to our assistance.

We may not be able to grasp the full meaning of the Holy Trinity, but knowing that God shares this with faithful people helps us to love God even more.



Una cosa que demuestra es que Dios quiere ser conocido por nosotros. En la antigüedad, la gente esperaba que sus dioses fueran misteriosos y ocultos. Muchas culturas pensaban que se podía controlar a un espíritu o dios si se conocía su nombre. Dios no nos ve como una amenaza, sino como hijos amados. Así como una pareja que se enamora quiere saber todo el uno del otro, así también Dios quiere ser conocido por los que ama. Esto me lleva al segundo punto.

La Trinidad también nos muestra que “Dios es amor” (1 Juan 4,16) porque las tres Personas están unidas en un solo Dios. Dios nos llama a estar unidos en amor con Dios y entre nosotros. Recordemos que Dios nos conoce perfectamente y aun así nos ama. Sin embargo, conocer nuestras debilidades y nuestros pecados no disminuye el amor de Dios por nosotros.

Como si su propia vida, sus enseñanzas sobre el amor de Dios, sus milagros, su muerte y resurrección no fueran suficientes, Jesús nos dijo algo sobre Dios que nunca hubiéramos imaginado: hay tres Personas en un solo Dios. También es algo que no podemos comprender por completo. Así que, en lugar de intentar explicarlo, veamos lo que significa para nosotros los creyentes.
