

Sunday Reflection

The Gospel for this Sunday can sometimes give the impression that Jesus favored Mary over Martha. But if they had both sat down to listen, there would have been no dinner to serve to Jesus. He saw that Mary was content to listen to him, so Martha could have been content to prepare the meal for him. Remember the first reading, in which Abraham insisted on serving the visitors, whom he came to recognize as the Lord and two angels. He was rewarded with the assurance that he would soon have a son.

So simple acts of hospitality can also be how people can welcome the Lord into their homes. When we welcome someone into our homes as a visitor, or into our lives as a friend, we are also welcoming Christ. When we get to know someone better, we are also getting to know Christ.

And what about that “better part” that Mary had chosen? Are we sometimes like Martha, with too many things on our minds to be aware of the Lord? Sometimes we can’t avoid the distractions that are part of life. But if we keep the Lord on our minds we may be able to see which are distractions to be put aside, and which are opportunities to serve the Lord in a different way.

As we spend more time with the Lord in prayer, we begin to experience God’s peace, which gives us the ability to choose the better part.

Catholic Education?



Why do children go to school? You’re probably thinking, “That’s obvious. To learn, of course!” But is academic knowledge, alone, the end goal of the learning experience? What if the educational process could deliver on more than just one outcome? A Catholic education is a one-of-a-kind learning experience because it focuses on more than just academics. We believe that nurturing the entire person in mind, body, and spirit is necessary for a happy, healthy, and balanced life. Catholic Schools provide children with the invaluable opportunity to expand their knowledge, explore their passions, create community, strengthen their sense of self and come to know God all in one place.

Do Catholic schools have better education? According to data from the US Department of Education, only 31% of public school graduates go on to earn a bachelor’s degree, compared to 62% of Catholic school students.

Is a Catholic school curriculum differen? Catholic school curriculum goes far beyond academics. Teachers and other staff emphasize a child’s moral character, encouraging respect. Children are also taught excellent manners in the classroom. They are taught to respect each other, the space around them, themselves, and adults.

“Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam” AMDG Scholarship Criteria

Saint Pius X Catholic School will be awarding 20 students with AMDG Full Tuition Scholarships for the 2025 -2026 school year. The scholarship extends to the 2026-2027 school year and will cover half of the scheduled tuition for that year. For families with multiple children, the scholarship will cover (for two years) half of the tuition for the second child and children thereafter, in the same family. For the second year, participating families are responsible for all other 2026-2027 applicable fees (i.e, Registration Fee, Bldg. Fee, Book Fee, and Fundraiser Fee).

SCHOLARSHIP PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS:

- 2 year commitment from 2025 - 2027
- Must be a new family to Saint Pius X Catholic School (not available to transfer students)
- Must schedule a tour of the school
- Must schedule an interview with the Principal
- Upon acceptance, must fill out an online application to include FACTS Grant and Aid
- Must agree to volunteer between 4-6 hours/month
- Must be responsible for the following fees:
 - Registration Fee \$100.00/student; \$400.00 for sibling(s)
 - Fall Fundraiser \$250/family
 - Spring Fundraiser \$250/family
 - Walkathon \$250/family
 - Major Fundraiser Miscellaneous Events (i.e., Galas) \$150 /family *Total of \$1,000.00 for first student

Note: Failure to fulfill the two year enrollment commitment will result in paying the full tuition amount for the 2025 – 2026 school year.
