



Sunday Reflection

The Gospel for this Sunday can sometimes As we spend more time with the Lord in Recuerden la primera lectura, en la que give the impression that Jesus favored Mary prayer, we begin to experience God's peace, over Martha. But if they had both sat down to which gives us the ability to choose the better listen, there would have been no dinner to part. serve to Jesus. He saw that Mary was content to listen to him, so Martha could have been content to prepare the meal for him. Remember the first reading, in which Abraham insisted on serving the visitors, whom he came to recognize as the Lord and two angels. He was rewarded with the assurance that he would soon have a son.

So simple acts of hospitality can also be how people can welcome the Lord into their homes. When we welcome someone into our homes as a visitor, or into our lives as a friend, we are also welcoming Christ. When we get to know someone better, we are also getting to know Christ.

And what about that "better part" that Mary had chosen? Are we sometimes like Martha, with too many things on our minds to be aware of the Lord? Sometimes we can't avoid the distractions that are part of life. But if we keep the Lord on our minds we may be able to see which are distractions to be put aside, and which are opportunities to serve the Lord in a different way.

A veces no podemos evitar las distracciones que son parte de la vida. Pero si tenemos presente al Señor, podremos ver cuáles son las distracciones que debemos dejar de lado y cuáles son oportunidades para servir al Señor de una manera diferente. A medida que pasamos más tiempo con el Señor en la oración, comenzamos a experimentar la paz de Dios, que nos da la capacidad de elegir la mejor parte.

"Ad Mejorem Def Gloriem" AMDG Sebolarship Griteria

Saint Pius X Catholic School will be awarding 20 students with AMDG Full Tuition Scholarships for the 2025 -2026 school year. The scholarship extends to the 2026-2027 school year and will cover half of the scheduled tuition for that year. For families with multiple children, the scholarship will cover (for two years) half of the tuition for the second child and children thereafter, in the same family. For the second year, participating families are responsible for all other 2026-2027 applicable fees (i.e, Registration Fee, Bldg. Fee, Book Fee, and Fundraiser Fee).

2 year commitment from 2025 - 2027

Must be a new family to Saint Pius X Catholic School (not available to transfer students)

Must schedule a tour of the school

Must schedule an interview with the Principal

Upon acceptance, must fill out an online application to include FACTS Grant and Aid

Must agree to volunteer between 4-6 hours/month

Spring Fundraiser \$250/family

Major Fundraiser Miscellaneous Events (i.e., Galas) \$150 /family *Total of \$1,000.00 for first student

Note: Failure to fulfill the two year enrollment commitment will result in paying the full tuition amount for the 2025 – 2026 school year.
