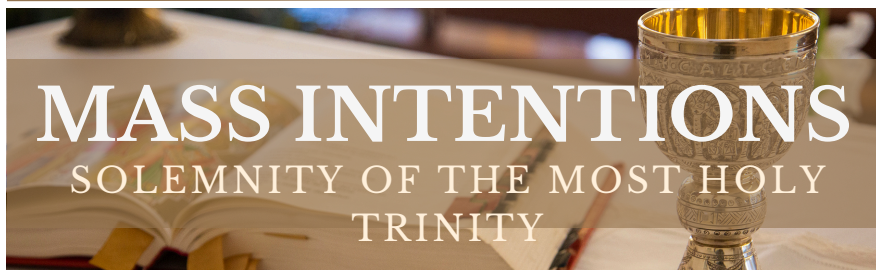

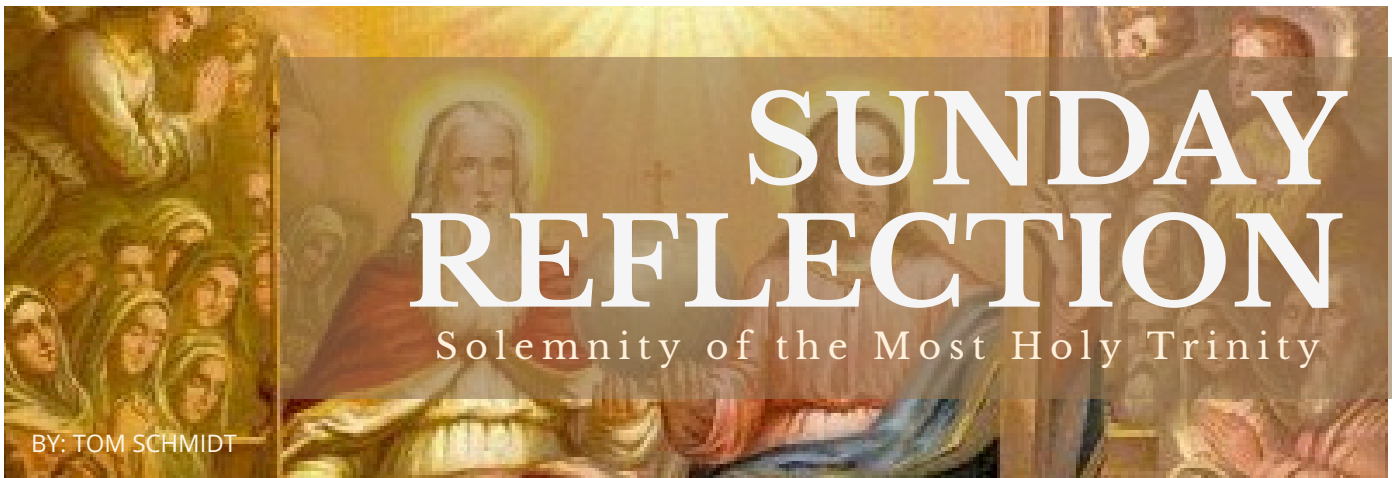

“Offering a Mass for someone, whether living or deceased, is considered the highest form of prayer in the Catholic faith, applying the infinite graces of Christ’s sacrifice for a specific need. It acts as a profound intercession for healing, comfort, special intentions, or the repose of a soul.”



Why does God love us so much? And why are we able to love others? The answer to these questions is found in the meaning of today's feast. Trinity Sunday celebrates not so much an idea of three-in-one, as the relationship of the Persons of the Trinity with each other and with us. The idea of the Trinity is based on love. But God's love was so great, God went even further. God created us to be loved by God.

Though human love is not perfect, the love of man and woman can produce another person, a child. The three Persons of the Trinity share one life in God. But through baptism we also share in God's life. Just as parents love to see how their children look like them, so God loves to see the divine in us.

Our decision to love is a response to God's love, and our ability to love is itself a gift from God. The meaning of life, the universe, and everything is Love, the love of the Trinity for each other and for us. The question now is, how well do we use that gift of God's love by loving each other?

¿Por qué Dios nos ama tanto? ¿Y por qué somos capaces de amar a los demás? La respuesta a estas preguntas se encuentra en el significado de la fiesta de hoy. La Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad no celebra tanto una idea de tres en uno sino la relación de las Personas de la Trinidad entre sí y con nosotros. La idea de la Trinidad tiene su fundamento en el amor. Pero el amor de Dios fue tan grande que quiso tomarlo aún más allá. Dios nos creó para ser amados por Dios.

Aunque el amor humano no es perfecto, el amor entre el hombre y la mujer puede producir a otra persona, a un bebé. Las tres Personas de la Trinidad comparten una sola vida en Dios. Pero a través del bautismo también compartimos la vida de Dios. Así como a los padres les encanta ver cómo sus hijos se parecen a ellos, a Dios le encanta ver lo divino en nosotros.

Nuestra decisión de amar es una respuesta al amor de Dios, y nuestra capacidad de amar es en sí misma un regalo de Dios. El sentido de la vida, del universo y de todo es el Amor, el amor de la Trinidad por los demás y por nosotros. La pregunta ahora es, ¿cómo utilizamos ese regalo del amor de Dios para amarnos unos a otros?

Prayer is the heart of Eucharistic stewardship, because it is in the presence of Jesus that we learn that everything we are and everything we have is a gift from God. In every Eucharist, we contemplate the love of Christ, who gives Himself completely for us, and that same love invites us to respond with gratitude, generosity, and commitment toward our community and our Church.

Prayer transforms our hearts and helps us understand that our material possessions, our time, and our talents do not belong only to us, but are gifts entrusted to us by God to serve others. When we live an authentic life of prayer, we stop seeing giving as an obligation and begin to see it as an expression of love and gratitude to God. Prayer teaches us to trust more in the Lord's providence and less in our own material security.

The Eucharist also reminds us that the Church is our spiritual family. It is not simply a place we attend on Sundays, but the community where we receive the sacraments, grow in faith, and encounter the living presence of Christ. For this reason, we all share the responsibility of supporting the mission of the Church, not only through our prayers and service, but also through our financial support. Every offering, no matter how small it may seem, becomes an act of faith and love that helps keep God's work alive in our community.

A person who prays constantly discovers that true generosity is born from a heart united to Christ. Prayer opens our souls to compassion, makes us more aware of the needs of others, and inspires us to share with joy. In this way, our Eucharistic stewardship becomes a grateful response to God's immense gift, reflecting in our lives the generous love of Jesus, who in the Eucharist continues to give Himself for all of us.

La oración es el corazón de la corresponsabilidad eucarística, porque es en la presencia de Jesús donde aprendemos que todo lo que somos y todo lo que tenemos es un regalo de Dios. En cada Eucaristía contemplamos el amor de Cristo que se entrega completamente por nosotros, y ese mismo amor nos invita a responder con gratitud, generosidad y compromiso hacia nuestra comunidad y nuestra Iglesia.

La oración transforma nuestro corazón y nos ayuda a comprender que nuestros bienes materiales, nuestro tiempo y nuestros talentos no nos pertenecen únicamente a nosotros, sino que son dones confiados por Dios para servir a los demás. Cuando vivimos una vida de oración auténtica, dejamos de ver el dar como una obligación y comenzamos a verlo como una expresión de amor y agradecimiento a Dios. Orar nos enseña a confiar más en la providencia del Señor y menos en nuestras propias seguridades materiales.

La Eucaristía también nos recuerda que la Iglesia es nuestra familia espiritual. No es solamente un lugar al que asistimos los domingos, sino la comunidad donde recibimos los sacramentos, crecemos en la fe y encontramos la presencia viva de Cristo. Por eso, todos compartimos la responsabilidad de sostener la misión de la Iglesia, no solo con nuestra oración y servicio, sino también con nuestra ayuda económica. Cada ofrenda, por pequeña que parezca, se convierte en un acto de fe y amor que ayuda a mantener viva la obra de Dios en nuestra comunidad.

Una persona que ora constantemente descubre que la verdadera generosidad nace de un corazón unido a Cristo. La oración abre nuestra alma a la compasión, nos hace más conscientes de las necesidades de los demás y nos impulsa a compartir con alegría. Así, nuestra corresponsabilidad eucarística se convierte en una respuesta agradecida al inmenso don de Dios, reflejando en nuestra vida el amor generoso de Jesús, quien en la Eucaristía continúa entregándose por todos nosotros.

The Sanctuary Lamp

Pagar por una vela o veladora del Santísimo Sacramento es un acto de devoción católica, a menudo llamado "vela votiva", que simboliza una intención especial, oración o agradecimiento ante la presencia real de Cristo. Representa dejar el corazón unido a Dios, ofreciendo luz, fe y esperanza por una necesidad particular. La vela encendida ante el Santísimo representa la luz de Cristo y es un signo visible de la oración de los fieles que permanece ante Él, incluso cuando la persona se retira. Se encienden para pedir favores, en agradecimiento por oraciones contestadas, o como señal de solidaridad y amor hacia alguien. Más allá del costo material, es una ofrenda espiritual que simboliza la fe, la esperanza y el deseo de quemar el egoísmo o dificultades personales. Es una forma de extender la oración y mantener la presencia espiritual en momentos de dificultad o gratitud.

Paying for a votive candle before the Blessed Sacrament is an act of Catholic devotion, often called a "votive candle," that symbolizes a special intention, prayer, or expression of gratitude before the Real Presence of Christ. It represents uniting one's heart to God, offering light, faith, and hope for a particular need. The candle lit before the Blessed Sacrament represents the light of Christ and is a visible sign of the prayer of the faithful that remains before Him, even after the person leaves. They are lit to ask for favors, in gratitude for answered prayers, or as a sign of solidarity and love for someone. Beyond the material cost, it is a spiritual offering that symbolizes faith, hope, and the desire to burn away selfishness or personal difficulties. It is a way to extend prayer and maintain spiritual presence in times of difficulty or gratitude.

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of El Paso Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026.

The Diocese of El Paso ("Diocese") has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case, *In re: Diocese of El Paso* (Bankr. W.D. Tx.). This notice is a short summary. For more detail, go to <https://cases.stretto.com/dioceesofelpaso> or call (833) 345-0351.

Who Should File a Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below. If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Claim?

You should file a claim using either Official Bankruptcy Form No. 410 (or a form substantially similar thereto) or the Abuse Proof of Claim Supplement Claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026. If you do not file a timely claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.
