"Offering a Mass for someone, whether living or deceased, is considered the highest form of prayer in the Catholic faith, applying the infinite graces of Christ's sacrifice for a specific need. It acts as a profound intercession for healing, comfort, special intentions, or the repose of a soul."



"Do not fear men," Jesus says. He is talking about fearing those who persecute you for your faith. In the verses preceding this Gospel passage, he tries to prepare us for persecution and says that just as people did to him (Jesus), they would do to his followers. But he triumphed over his persecutors. They could not stop him. And that is what he promises us as well. We cannot be destroyed as long as we hold on to that faith.

The best way to maintain faith is to share it with others. It sounds like a contradiction, but it means that when we spread faith, our faith grows as well. And when we allow others to share their faith with us, we feel encouraged and supported.

Sometimes we may hesitate when speaking about faith. The only thing we should fear is our weakness, not Satan's power. That's why Jesus said that whoever denies him before men, he will also deny him. However, Jesus died for our sins, so not even they can destroy us if we turn to the Lord. So thank Him for His forgiveness, but don't forget to spread the news that you have been forgiven. You might encourage someone else to have the courage to return to the Lord, and thus achieve another victory of faith that overcomes fear.

"No teman a los hombres", dice Jesús. Está hablando de temer a los que les persiguen a causa de la fe. En los versículos anteriores a este pasaje evangélico, intenta prepararnos para la persecución y dice que así como lo hicieron a él (Jesús), lo harían a sus seguidores. Pero triunfó sobre sus perseguidores. No pudieron detenerlo. Y eso es lo que nos promete a nosotros también. No podemos ser destruidos mientras mantengamos esa fe.

La mejor forma de mantener la fe es regalándola a otros. Suena como una contradicción, pero significa que cuando difundimos la fe, nuestra fe también crece. Y cuando permitimos que otros compartan su fe con nosotros, nos sentimos alentados y apoyados.

A veces podemos dudar al hablar sobre la fe. Lo único que debemos temer es nuestra debilidad, no el poder de Satanás. Por eso Jesús dijo que al que le niegue delante de los hombres, él también lo negará. Sin embargo, Jesús murió por nuestros pecados, así que ni siquiera ellos pueden destruirnos si nos volvemos al Señor. Así que agradécele su perdón, pero no te olvides de difundir la noticia que hayas sido perdonado. Podrías animar a otra persona a tener el valor de volver al Señor, y así lograr otra victoria de la fe que vence al miedo.

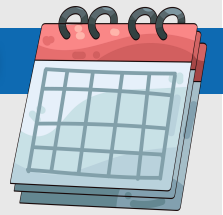

Public Notice – Action Required

Sexual Abuse Claims in the Diocese of El Paso Bankruptcy

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred,
you need to file your claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026.

The Diocese of El Paso ("Diocese") has filed bankruptcy to restructure its nonprofit organization and pay Putative Abuse Survivors. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case. *In re: Diocese of El Paso (Bankr. W.D. Tx.)*. This notice is a short summary. For more detail, go to <https://cases.stretto.com/diocesefelpaso> or call (833) 345-0351.

Who Should File a Claim?

Anyone who alleges they were abused and believes the Diocese, or persons affiliated with the Diocese, may be responsible for the abuse must file a claim. This includes abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese, including schools, orphanages, parishes, or Catholic Charities. A list of such entities associated with the Diocese is available on the website or by calling the toll-free number listed below. If you have an abuse claim against any entity on that list, you may have a claim against the Diocese. Only the Diocese is in bankruptcy. If you have a claim against any entity on that list, you must take additional legal action to preserve and pursue your rights.

When and How Should I File a Claim?

You should file a claim using either Official Bankruptcy Form No. 410 (or a form substantially similar thereto) or the Abuse Proof of Claim Supplement Claim so that it is received by September 11, 2026. If you do not file a timely claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese, including any right to compensation.
