- Aiming to comply with all relevant legislative requirements including regulations, standards and codes of
 practice, and where appropriate legislative requirements do not exist, implement standards that reflect
 Prolux electrical contractor's commitment to health and safety;
- Providing appropriate consultation, education and training for employees to equip them to safely perform
 their tasks including safety in design and communicating openly with employees on occupational health
 and safety issues; and
- Being prepared for emergencies to ensure the safety and security of all staff and visitors.
