Dear Parishioners,

Everyone knows we can expect a major Sunday snowstorm, so our wardens, staff and I have worked to monitor weather forecasts while adapting our Sunday worship and Annual Meeting for everyone's safety.

This Sunday, January 25, we will hold one worship service, our usual 8:00 Rite 1 Eucharist (no music) in the Church. We will postpone our breakfast and table conversations one week (see below) but hold our leadership elections and treasurer's report at 9:00 in the Great Hall. I invite a couple volunteers to make pots of coffee/tea but we will otherwise have no food. We expect to complete our work by 10:00 and will cancel our normal 10:00 worship out of an abundance of caution. If you wish to stay home, you can still join our 9:00 business meeting online via [this Zoom link](#) with passcode: 012526. We will turn on the Zoom access at 8:45.

Next Sunday, February 1, we will cancel our 8:00 liturgy in order to begin 8:30 breakfast and fellowship in the Great Hall, followed by 9:00 table discussions originally scheduled for this week. At about 10:00 or 10:15, we will celebrate the Eucharist in the Great Hall with Canon Kelly O'Connell as our preacher. We will have an online option for the table discussions--details to follow in next week's e-news.

I hope you find this as an acceptable adaptation to a rugged winter weather forecast. I look forward to seeing you in person or online this Sunday and next.


