Our security team has become one of the most visible and critical services the Studio City Business District provides. The team works 7 days a week from 10 am to 6 pm improving the safety of our public spaces in the Studio City BID. The team ensures sidewalks remain unobstructed, trespassing is minimized and pedestrians and businesses feel safer. We know many of you have seen and met our team.

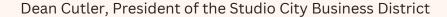
As a result of our constant vigilance, we are seeing fewer and fewer incidents of tenting and camping such as these (each of which we resolved):

- NoHo Home Alliance: A local non-profit organization that offers a community-based solution to homelessness. NoHo Home Alliance hosts a Drop-In Access Center 4 days a week which provides food, showers, mail service, clothing as well as support services such as housing navigation to our unhoused neighbors. Once a week they are in Studio City.
