STATEMENT OF CAPACITY - TOBYHANNA CHAPTER 94

POCONO AND TOBYHANNA TOWNSHIPS MONROE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA T&M PROJECT NO. POCS00010

Dear Mr. Briegel:

We have been requested to prepare a report and statement of capacity in support of the Tobyhanna Service Area Act 537 Amendment submitted on behalf of Kalahari Resort. We offer the following:

SERVICE AREA BACKGROUND

The Tobyhanna Service Area provides services to a single customer, Kalahari Resorts. Pocono Township has been providing bulk sewage services to Tobyhanna Township pursuant to an agreement entitled Intermunicipal Sewage Collection and Disposal Services Agreement (ISCA), dated September 30, 2013. This agreement obligates Tobyhanna to certain restrictions provided within the agreement and, by reference, Pocono's Resolutions governing the sewer system.

Subsequent to the ISCA, Pocono, Tobyhanna and BCRA entered into an agreement entitled Intermunicipal Sewage Service Area Agreement (IMA) dated December 30, 2013. This agreement provides BCRA and Pocono the authority to regulate uses and conditions of uses in the Tobyhanna Service Area.

Also subsequent to the above agreements, Kalahari, through Tobyhanna prepared, submitted, and obtained approvals for sewage planning modules (SPM) for full development of the Tobyhanna Service area for the Kalahari Resort (230,000 gpd) and Pocono Mountain Investors (PMI) (210,000 gpd). Kalahari constructed a portion of the resort proposed in the original SPM, and the actual generated flows exceeded the estimated flows in the SPM.

Kalahari then purchased capacity originally planned for use by PMI, to account for those exceedances in capacity. This brought its total purchased capacity to 252,928 gpd (1,024 EDUs) and, thereby reduced PMI's available, but unpurchased, capacity to 187,072 gpd. The PADEP has directed Tobyhanna, through its customer Kalahari to prepare Act 537 Sewage Planning Modules to account for the exchange in capacity from one development area to the other. Kalahari has stated that it has no future development plans on the Kalahari property, and there have been no development plans disclosed to Pocono for the PMI lands.



COLLECTION AND CONVEYANCE SYSTEMS

The collection system is composed of multiple parts flowing by a combination of gravity and pump stations from the Kalahari Resort to Pocono Township Pump Station 5. Those subareas are as follows:

- 1. Kalahari Owned Collection and Conveyance System Kalahari operates a sewage pump station at the resort that collects flows from the hotel, waterpark, conference center, and employee housing facilities. The capacity and configuration of this pump station is unknown to Pocono Township. This pump station conveyance flows along Kalahari Boulevard, connecting what is presumed to be a small grinder pump at Gorilla Cove, then connecting to Tobyhanna's Pump Station.
- 2. Tobyhanna's pump station was permitted under PADEP Permit No. 4513401. The pump station was proposed as three phases: 162 gpm, 503 gpm, and 764 gpm. The construction of the pump station currently mimics the originally proposed Phase 2 of 503 gpm or a maximum daily flow of 289,728 gpd. The pump station currently conveys a sustained forward flow of 410 gpm, or an actual installed capacity of 236,160 gpd. Kalahari is proposing to install an EQ tank system which would reduce required peaking factors from 2.5 to 1.5, or a capacity, once the EQ tank is constructed and if properly sized, of 393,600 gpd on a peak day design basis.
- 3. The Tobyhanna pump station conveyance flows through an 8" force main, which is metered at Pocono Township Pump Station 1 near the intersection of SR 611 and SR 314 in Swiftwater and eventually connects to Pocono Township Manhole B1-1-01 in Pocono Subarea 5-9. The downstream collection system from this connection point consists of an 18" gravity main with the flattest section installed at 0.3% slope and a maximum capacity of 1,377,792 gpd (2,392 gpm). It is noted that this connection point is common to Sanofi Pasteur (750 gpm), Pocono Pump Station No. 1 (352 gpm), 61 EDUs (21 gpm) connected by gravity, and reserved capacity by future users totaling 370 additional EDUs (159 gpm). Not including the Sanofi Pasteur and Tobyhanna flows, the available capacity of this subarea is 639,360 gpd (1,110 gpm). Pocono Township has studied its collection system as-built conditions and, as it relates to the available capacity, this section of sewer line is the critical limitation to the service area. This report is entitled "Report on Conveyance Capacity for Pocono Township Sanitary Sewer Conveyance System" dated October 2023, as prepared by LVL Engineering Group.
- 4. The sewage flow is by gravity from MH B1-1-01 to Pocono Pump Station 5, located at the northerly intersection of Bartonsville Avenue and SR 611 in Bartonsville. The conveyance system has a maximum peak daily flow of 2,054,592 gpd (3,567 gpm). The pump station has a total of 4,987 EDUs either purchased or reserved totaling 881,049 gpd (1,460 gpm). Note that this flow does include purchased Kalahari Capacity but does not include any planned flows from PMI.
- 5. Flows from Pump Station 5 travel through 8 miles of 20", 16", and 12" force mains, connecting to Pump Stations 3 and 4 along the route ultimately to the BCRA Regional WWTP.

TREATMENT AND DISPOSAL

The treatment and disposal services are provided by agreement with BCRA at its WWTP in Stroudsburg, PA. The Pocono Capacity in the WWTP is 2.0 MGD measured as a monthly average, 4.0 MGD on any peak day, and 6.0 MGD instantaneous peak flow (2 hours). These constraints are also the design and permit basis of the headworks at the WWTP.



SUMMARY OF CAPACITY

It is noted that this is based on an average day, as measured by a monthly average, and a peaking factor of no more than 2.5. Any flows which exceed the average monthly flow or a peaking factor of 2.5, will cause reduced available capacity in the system both by way of conveyance capacity and treatment capacity at the WWTP. It is further advised that should users ignore the design basis of a monthly average with a 2.5 peaking factor, the collection and conveyance system could become hydraulicly overloaded.

We recommend the Township draft a capacity letter stating that it can provide services for the Tobyhanna Service Area for up to 440,000 gpd. It should be noted; however, that only capacity for 252,928 gpd is being certified at this time. The remaining 187,072 gpd capacity is currently available but cannot be reserved until such a time that Tobyhanna officially reserves or purchases the capacity. This letter should be referenced in the capacity letter and included as an attachment.

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has received and reviewed the revision to the official plan for the above referenced development and has identified the following technical deficiencies. The items are based on applicable laws and regulations, and the guidance sets forth DEP's preferred means of satisfying applicable regulatory requirements.

Technical Deficiencies

The Component 3 Sewage Facilities Planning Module:

- 1. Please provide a Resolution of Adoption affixed with the municipal seal from Pocono Township.
- 2. Please edit the project narrative to clarify or include the following information:
 - a. Please include a sewage flow breakdown for the 252,928 GPD of existing sewage flow to the Kalahari Resort and Conference Center.
 - b. Please address the intentions and sewage flow allocations for Parcel 19.2.1.1-6.
- 3. Please clarify Component 3, Section G.1.a & b. -Proposed Wastewater Disposal Facilities. These sections state that a pump station, force main, and an extension to the existing collection system are part of this planning module submission, in order to serve 1,782 EDU's and four (4) connections. Please note that a copy of this section may be required from Tobyhanna Township, if they are owners, or part-owners of the collection system.

4. Please provide a full-size copy (3' X 4') of the plot plan and ensure it contains the requirements listed under Component 3, Section G.3 -Plot Plan.

- 5. Please address the data reported under Component 3, Section J Chapter 94 Consistency Determination. Specifically, the figures do not appear to include actual existing flow data from Pocono Township's conveyance system or the Brodhead Creek Regional Authority.
- 6. Please provide the final copy of the Pennsylvania Natural Diversity Index (PNDI) report with Section 7 & 8 completed, signed, and dated. The version submitted is a draft copy.

All requested materials must be submitted by the municipality and a copy of this letter with the certification statement completed by a township official must be included with the submittal.

If you believe that any of the stated deficiencies are not significant; instead of submitting a response to that deficiency, you have the option of asking DEP to make a decision based on the information with regard to the subject matter of that deficiency that you have already made available. If you choose this option with regard to any deficiency, you should explain and justify how your current submission satisfies that deficiency. Please keep in mind that if you fail to respond, your application may be denied.

Please note that the current due date for approval/denial action by DEP is February 8, 2025. Please submit any materials or information addressing the deficiencies no later than January 8, 2025.

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE THE CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL OF THE RUNNING LANE, LLC PRELIMINARY/FINAL LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the applicant, Running Lane, LLC, submitted a preliminary/final land development plan (the "Plan"). The applicant proposes a land development on property located along State Route 0611, approximately 0.7 miles south of the intersection with Lower Swiftwater Road (SR 0314). 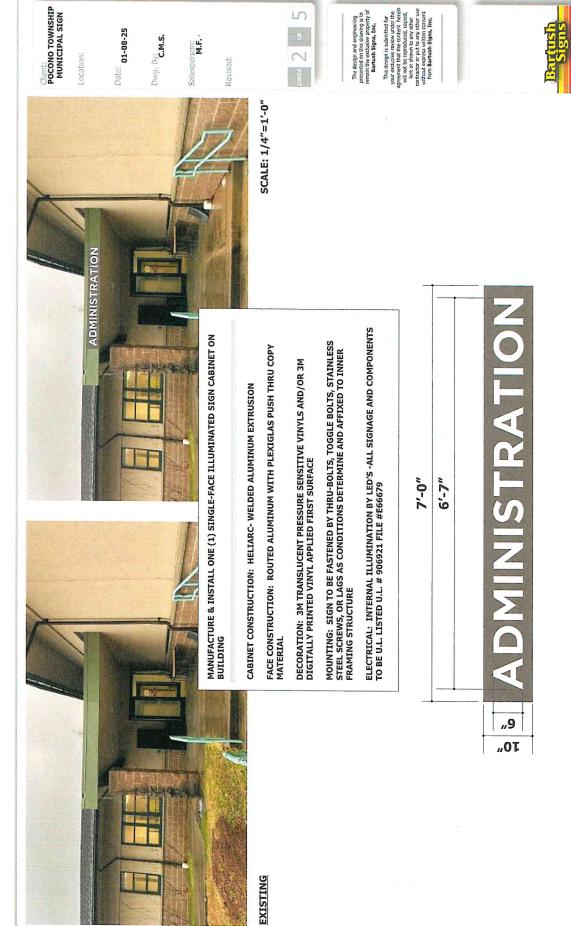

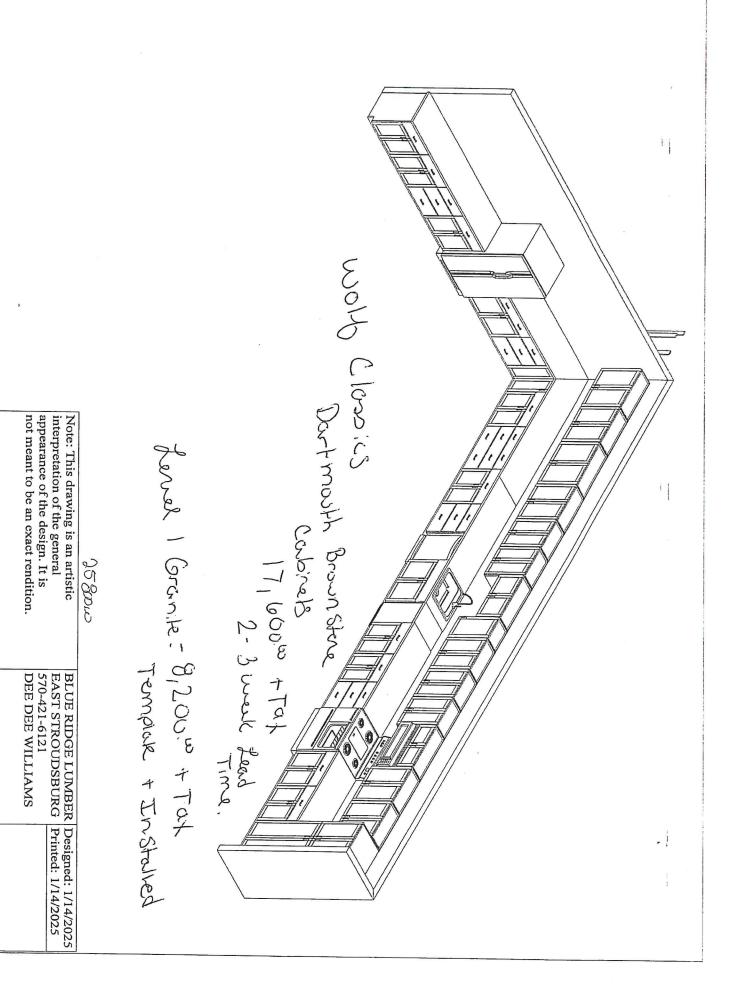

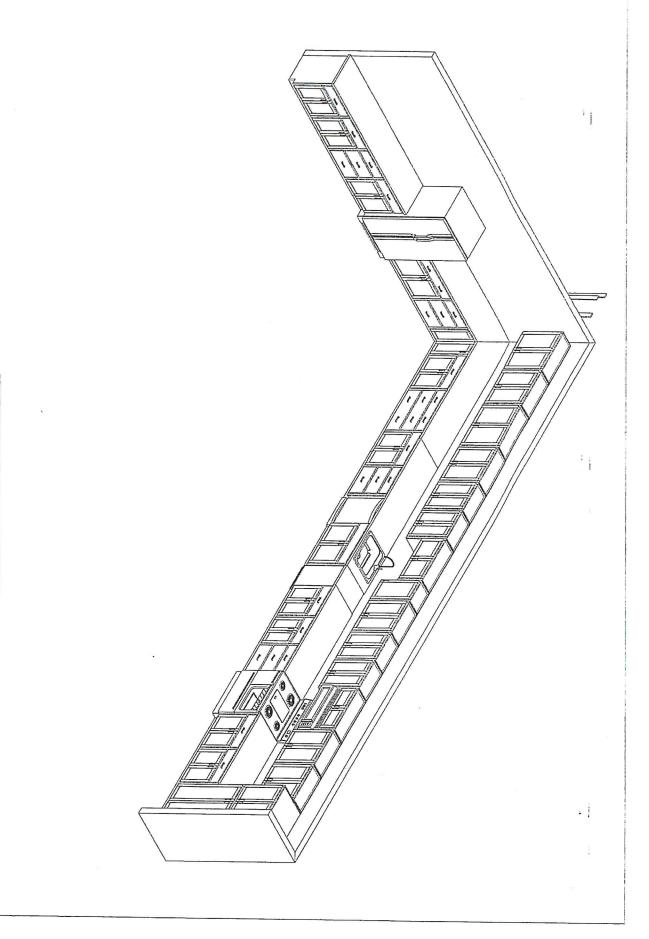
