WHEREAS, the applicants, Michael A. Persoleo and Kathleen B. Persoleo, submitted a lot consolidation plan application titled "Lands of Michael A. Persoleo and Kathleen B. Persoleo, Lot Joinder Plan, Lot 1 and Lot 50" (the "Plan"). The Plan proposes to consolidate two existing parcels into one parcel located along Waterview Drive. The existing parcels are identified as Monroe County Tax Parcel I.D.'s 12.16A.1.293 and 12.16A.1.43; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the Plan and offered comments in his letters dated October 28, 2024 and November 22, 2024; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Pocono Township, County of Monroe, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

Persoleo, Lot Joinder Plan, Lot 1 and Lot 50" as shown on the lot consolidation plan prepared by Trout Creek, LLC, dated September 25, 2024, as revised, be hereby approved with the following conditions and provided the plan is revised as follows, subject to the review and approval of the Township Engineer and/or Township Solicitor:

- 1. The applicants shall comply with all of the conditions and requirements identified in the Township Engineer's letters dated October 28, 2024 and November 22, 2024.
- 2. The applicants shall provide the Township with a copy of the proposed deed of consolidation, which deed shall be recorded concurrently with the Plan.
- 3. The applicants shall pay all necessary fees associated with the Plan, including but not limited to any outstanding plan account charges and all professional services fees, prior to the recording of the Plan.
- 4. The applicants shall obtain all required permits and approvals from other governmental agencies prior to presenting the Plan for signatures.
- 5. The applicants shall provide the requisite number of plans which are signed and notarized by the owner and sealed by the engineer.

- 6. The applicants shall meet all conditions of the final plan approval, and Plan shall be recorded within twelve (12) months of Conditional final plan approval, and agrees that if such conditions are not met, the Conditional final plan approval will be considered void.
- 7. The applicants shall accept these conditions in writing within five (5) days of receipt of the Board of Commissioners Resolution, otherwise the application is denied.

Pursuant to the Township's request, we have performed our second review of the above referenced project. The submitted information consists of the following items.

- Description of Proposed Lot 143A prepared by Trout Creek, LLC.
- Monroe County Planning Commission Receipt of Plan Submittal.
- Lot Closure Report for Proposed Lot 50A prepared by Trout Creek, LLC, dated November 17, 2024.
- Existing Lot 50 Property Deed, Deed Book 2119, Page 1365.
- Plan entitled "Lands of Michael A. Persoleo and Kathleen B. Persoleo, Lot Joinder Plan, Lot 1 and Lot 50", prepared by Trout Creek, LLC, dated September 25, 2024, revised November 17, 2024.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Applicant is proposing to combine two (2) existing properties located along Waterview Drive. Parcel No. 12.16A.1.43 is located at 1375 Waterview Drive.

Existing Lot 1 (Parcel ID No. 12.16A.1.293), owned by the applicant, has an area of 0.339 acres and is located within the R-1, Low Density Residential Zoning District. The property currently contains two (2) sheds and existing woodlands.

Existing Lot 50 (Parcel ID No. 12.16A.1.43), owned by the applicant, has an area of 0.342 acres and is located within the R-1, Low Density Residential Zoning District. It currently contains an existing house, private well, on-lot sewage disposal system, and gravel driveway.

The proposed consolidated parcel will have a total area of 0.681 acres. The Existing Lots are both bordered to the east by Crescent Lake.

Based upon our review of the above information, we offer the following comments and/or recommendations for your consideration.

ZONING ORDINANCE COMMENTS

- 1. In accordance with Section 470-17.C.(1) and Attachment 2, the required minimum lot area is two (2) acres. Existing Lots 1 and 50 have existing areas of 0.339 acres and 0.342 acres, respectively, and are existing non-conformities. The proposed lot consolidation will create one (1) lot having a total area of 0.681 acres and will reduce the existing non-conformity. (Previous Comment 1 from Review No. 1) No action is required.
- 2. In accordance with Section 470-17.C.(1) and Attachment 2, the required minimum lot width is 200 feet. Existing Lot 1 has a lot width of 100-feet ± and Existing Lot 50 has a lot width of 102-feet ±. The existing lots are nonconformities. The proposed lot consolidation will create one (1) lot having a total width of 202-feet ± and will eliminate the existing non-conformity. (Previous Comment 2 from Review No. 1) No action is required.
- 3. In accordance with Section 470-17.C.(1) and Attachment 2, the required minimum front yard depth is 50 feet and the required minimum side yard width is 25-feet. The existing dwelling on Lot 50 is located within the required front and side yards and is an existing non-conformity. The proposed lot consolidation does not affect the existing non-conformity related to the front yard and will eliminate the existing non-conformity related to the side yard. (Previous Comment 3 from Review No. 1) No action is required.
- 4. In accordance with Section 470-31, "all accessory buildings shall be required to adhere to the minimum yard dimensions established for the district in which the building is located". The existing sheds are located within the required front and rear yards. Also, the shed located within the required rear yard is split by the existing property line shared between Existing Lots 1 and 50. The locations of the sheds are existing non-conformities. The proposed lot consolidation will provide the rear shed on one (1) lot. The other nonconformities related to the locations in the front and rear yards will remain and will not be affected by the lot consolidation plan. (Previous Comment 4 from Review No. 1) No action is required.

SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE COMMENTS

5. In accordance with Section 390-18.E, "no official action shall be taken by the Board of Commissioners until either the Township has received the comments of the Monroe County Planning Commission or a period of 30 days has expired following transmittal of the preliminary plan to the County Planning Commission". (Previous Comment 5 from Review No. 1) A Receipt of Plan Submittal to the Monroe County Planning Commission dated October 11, 2024 has been received with this submission.

All previous engineering related comments have been addressed. The remaining comments are related to existing non-conformities and outside agency comments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Applicant is proposing to combine two (2) existing properties located along Mattiola Road. Parcel No. 12.9A.2.39 is located at 1216 Mattiola Road.

Existing Lot 142 (Parcel ID No. 12.9A.2.40), owned by the applicant, has an area of 0.399 acres and is located within the R-1, Low Density Residential Zoning District. The property is currently vacant and consists of existing woodlands.

Existing Lot 143 (Parcel ID No. 12.9A.2.39), owned by the applicant, has an area of 0.348 acres and is located within the R-1, Low Density Residential Zoning District. It currently contains an existing house, private well, onlot sewage disposal system, and paved driveway.

The proposed consolidated parcel will have a total area of 0.747 acres.

Based upon our review of the above information, we offer the following comments and/or recommendations for your consideration.

Existing Lots 142 and 143 have existing areas of 0.399 acres and 0.348 acres, respectively, and are existing non-conformities. The proposed lot consolidation will create one (1) lot having a total area of 0.747 acres

The proposed lot consolidation will create one (1) lot having a total width of 189-feet ± and will reduce the existing non-conformity. (Previous Comment 2 from Review No. 1) No action is required.
- 3. In accordance with Section 470-17.C.(1) and Attachment 2, the required minimum front yard depth is 50 feet. The existing dwelling on Lot 143 is located within the required front yard and is an existing non-conformity. The proposed lot consolidation does not affect the existing non-conformity. (Previous Comment 3 from Review No. 1) No action is required.

Memorandum of Understanding

Teamsters Local Union No. 773

And

The Board of Commissioners for Pocono Township

Subject: Adjustment of Compensatory Time Policy for Public Works Employees for Calendar Year 2025

Date: 01/01/2025

Purpose:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the agreement between Teamsters Local Union No. 773 (hereinafter referred to as the "Union") and the Board of Commissioners for Pocono Township (hereinafter referred to as the "Employer") regarding the adjustment of compensatory (comp) time accrual for public works employees under the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) for the calendar year **2025 only**.

Agreement:

1. Duration:

o This MOU is effective from **January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025**. It applies exclusively to the calendar year 2025 and will not extend beyond this period unless mutually agreed upon in writing by both parties.

2. Compensatory Time Accrual:

- Employees shall be permitted to earn and accrue compensatory time at the applicable overtime rate in lieu of overtime pay.
- Employees will be permitted to accumulate compensatory time up to a maximum of **eighty (80) hours**, which shall be a recurring limit rather than an annual cap during 2025.
- Upon reaching the eighty (80) hour maximum, employees shall not be entitled to accrue additional compensatory time until they have utilized or cashed out existing comp time to bring their balance below the maximum limit.

3. Use and Cash-Out of Compensatory Time:

o At any time during 2025, employees may request to use their accrued compensatory time by submitting a written request to their supervisor no less than two (2) days before the intended use.

- Supervisors will respond to requests no later than one (1) day before the intended use, accommodating the request unless it unduly disrupts operations.
- Employees may request a payout of any or all of their accrued compensatory time on a quarterly basis during 2025. Earlier requests may be considered in cases of emergency, subject to approval by the Township Manager.

4. Carryover of Compensatory Time:

- At the end of the calendar year **2025**, employees may choose to carry over any unused compensatory time to the following year.
- o The carried-over hours will count toward the eighty (80) hour maximum in 2026, subject to the terms of the existing CBA or any subsequent agreements.

5. Separation from Employment:

o If an employee leaves Township employment or is promoted to an exempt status position during 2025, they shall receive a lump-sum payment for any unused compensatory time at their final regular hourly rate of pay.

6. Overtime and Compensatory Time Election:

 When eligible for overtime in 2025, employees wishing to accrue compensatory time must notify their supervisor in writing before the payroll for the applicable workweek is processed. Failure to provide such notice will result in receiving overtime pay.

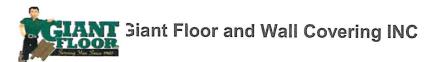
7. Miscellaneous Provisions:

- All other terms and conditions related to compensatory time, as outlined in the existing CBA, remain in full force and effect unless expressly modified by this MOU.
- This MOU supersedes any conflicting provisions in prior agreements regarding compensatory time accrual limits for the year 2025.
- o Any changes to compensatory time policies beyond December 31, 2025, will require negotiation and mutual agreement between the Union and the Employer.

Pursuant to the Township's request, we have reviewed a Waiver of Land Development Application for the above referenced project. The submitted information consists of the following items.

- Pocono Township Waiver of Land Development Application.
- Boundary Survey Map prepared by Brian D. Courtright, P.L.S., dated June 2024.
- Special Warranty Deed dated February 20, 2024.
- Professional Services Agreement and Escrow.
- Sheets A-1 (Plans & Elevations) and A-2 (Framing Plans & Details) of a 3-sheet plan set prepared by Bue-Morris Associates, Inc., dated October 14, 2024.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The subject parcel (Parcel ID No. 12.12.1.1) is located at the southeastern corner of the intersection of Cherry Lane Road and Laurel Lake Road and is owned by the Applicant, Mountain Villa Resort, LLC. It consists of a pre-existing non-conforming bed and breakfast with various outbuildings. The application proposes to replace an existing attached 5'-11" x 23'-10" enclosed porch with a new 16'-0" x 23'-11" room and an 8'-0" x 23'-11" composite deck. It is our understanding that the property owners plan to continue the bed and breakfast use on the property and the intended use of the space will be as a dining room/gathering area.

Based upon our review of the above information, we find this does not meet the eligibility requirements for a Waiver of Land Development because it is a non-residential structure with an expansion involving additional occupied space. Additionally, the construction of an addition to an existing building is defined as a "regulated activity" per Chapter 365-4.E.(5) which requires stormwater management and which shall be addressed by the applicant. Therefore, we do not recommend approval of the waiver request.

Pursuant to the Township's request, we have reviewed the Waiver of Land Development Application for the above-referenced project. Based on our review of the information provided, we do *not recommend* approval of the waiver request. Our office offers the following comments in support of our determination:

- 1. In accordance with Item G of the Pocono Township Waiver of Land Development Application, a proposed building addition shall not result in an expansion involving additional occupied space.
 - a. The proposed addition will create additional occupied space, and as a result, is not eligible for a waiver of Land Development.
- 2. The submitted plans do not demonstrate full compliance with the accessibility requirements outlined in Chapter 11 of the 2018 IBC (International Building Code) or Section 305.7 of the 2018 IEBC (International Existing Building Code).
 - a. Compliance with the above-referenced Chapter or Section may require improvements, such as the installation of a ramp or pedestrian-accessible walkway, which could expand the proposed addition or trigger the need for Land Development approval.

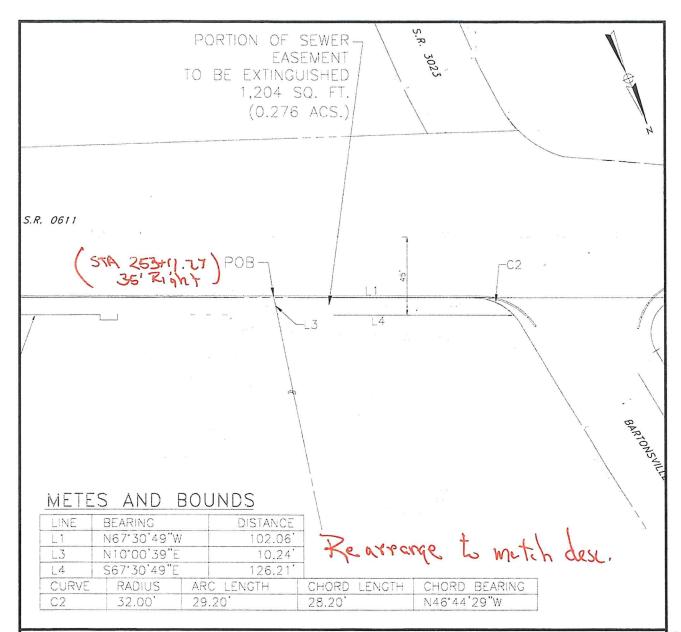

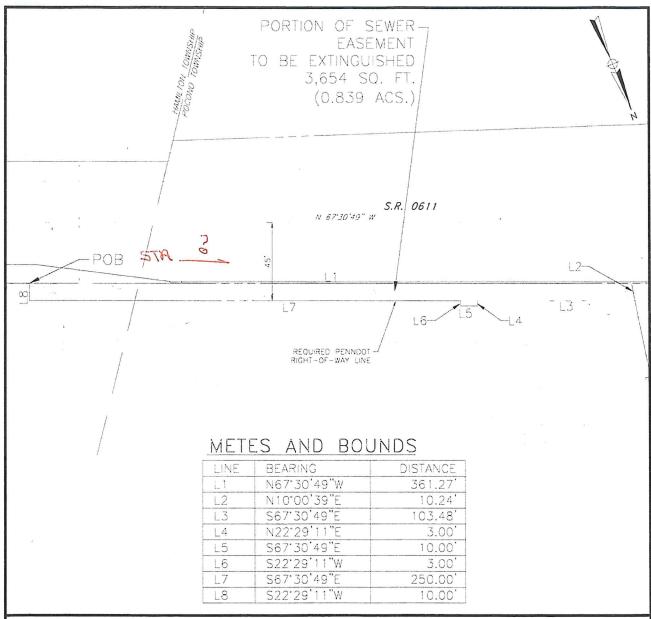

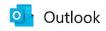

Jerrod—

Following are my comments to this Agreement:

- 1. Term and Condition 7--This is a four (4) year contract/commitment with an automatic renewal for four (4) years, unless terminated by at least 60 days written notice. Are we sure that the Township is willing to commit to a 4 year term? We should avoid the situation we have with the accountinting software. To do so, I would include a provision that permits the Townhip to terminate this agreement at any time by providing 60 days notice of its intent to do so, In addition, the renewal provision should be for one year terms not 4.
- 2. Term and Condition 6—Because of the way the meetings fall, the 10 day late fee and accruing interest needs to be removed.
- 3. Term and Consition 5—Are you OK with an annual 5% increase? At the 4th year the annual fee will be roughly \$6,800.00.
- 4. Term and Condition 3—The minimum annual committement is based on 22 users. If there is a staff reduction below that number, the Township is still committed to paying the minimum based upon 22 users. This should be revised perhaps by stating that the minimum users and associated fee will be established at the beginning of each contract year.

Pocono Township Parks and Recreation All Sports Field Use Policy

- 1. Registration for league play must be submitted and approved by Pocono Township. This can be done by completing the appropriate forms in person. All documentation must be provided at the time of registration.
- 2. Fields must be reserved prior to use. Any field NOT reserved may NOT be used.
- 3. Fields may be closed by the Township for any reason, in particular inclement weather, field maintenance, treatment, etc.
- 4. 48-hour advance notice must be provided for events requiring lines, additional grooming or other park staff support.
- 5. Each organization may use the field a maximum of two days per week each. Additional days will require additional board approval
- 6. Pocono Township must be named insured on all COIs from organization.
- 7. Contact information for league/team representative must be provided, to allow notification of scheduling changes/field closure.
- 8. All other park rules must be followed.
- 9. Per season fee for any league is \$250.00 (excluding PMELL)
