UCC Board Position

As a current member of the Pocono Township Planning Commission, I am writing to express my interest in a position on the UCC board. With over 30 years in the construction industry and lifelong residency of Pocono Township, I feel I can provide valuable knowledge, service and representation for the residents of Pocono Township. Nearly all my life I have been involved the construction Industry. At a very young age I was a heavy equipment operator digging foundations and building septic systems all over Pocono Township and Monroe County, for many different builders. I even swung a hammer now and then for a few of them.

While in high school studied welding at MCTI. I continued on to college starting out in civil engineering but ultimately graduating in 2008 with a degree in Welding and Fabrication Engineering. Upon graduating, I continued with self-employment as owner of VanFleet Welding, while also working at night for 2 years at the Tobyhanna Army Depot for Lockheed Martin.

In 2015 I became a certified welding inspector and took on the role of senior steel technician with Pennoni Associates. During my time with Pennoni as an inspector, I worked on several high-profile jobs throughout the Northeast representing more than 13 different departments of transportation and a large number of municipalities in areas concerning steel construction focusing largely on bridges and high-rise buildings. As an inspector representing the NYC DOT on one of the largest privately funded construction sites in the United States, The Hudson Yards, I have been in some situations many people would be unfamiliar with when it comes QA and QC related issues. The pressure can be immense at times, and you're not always liked, but code is law and public safety is paramount.

In 2016 I took a job with Durr Mechanical Construction as the fabrication shop manager and company welding inspector while working part time for Pennoni. Durr Mechanical used to occupy what is now the Kubota dealership across from Old Dominion and was one of the largest industrial mechanical contractors in the New York City area. I oversaw fabrication of piping for several heavy industrial applications mostly consisting of powerhouse construction steam transmission and process piping. Durr Mechanical has since gone out of business and I continue my profession in the construction industry as owner of VanFleet Welding.

Over my 23 years in business, I have worked on some of the larger projects in our area and the Northeast building several indoor water parks all over the United States including the Bahamas. I have also been a part of several large jobs at the Tobyhanna army Depot and Picatinny Arsenal. I am quite familiar with construction practices safety standards and codes. It's important to how to use and interpret the code books because codes can change over time, and some codes can conflict with other codes. Codes also have legal precedence.

Since 2017 I also work on occasion for the Gerson Lehrman Group as a consultant and professional witness on legal matters concerning steel construction and fabrication. I would also like to note my 15 years of service as a volunteer firefighter with Pocono Township. Building construction is very important when it comes to fighting fire. The materials used as well as the means and methods used in the time period all come into play when it comes to safety of the residents and more importantly our volunteer firefighters. Only a firefighter would know what I'm talking about. With all that I have mentioned I believe my experience is valuable and would like to thank you for your consideration of UCC board member. 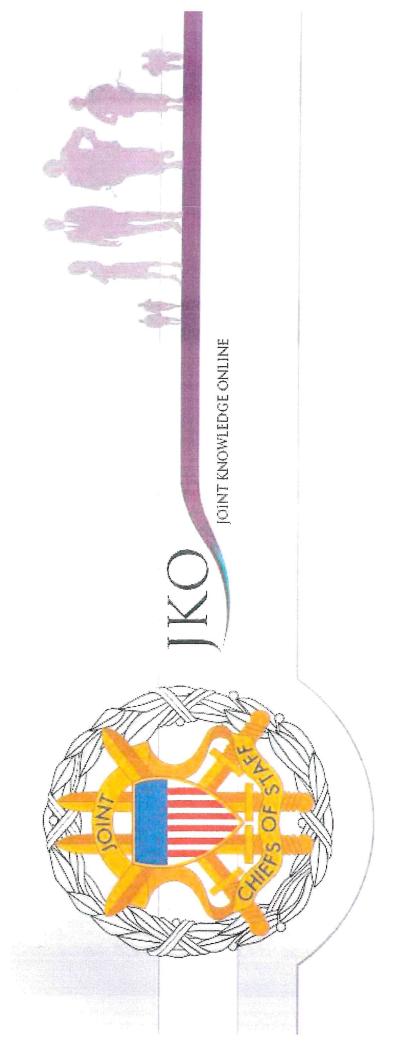

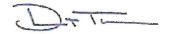

A RESOLUTION GRANTING CONDITIONAL PRELIMINARY/FINAL LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN APPROVAL OF BROOKSTEAD APARTMENTS

WHEREAS, the applicant, Brookstead, LLC, submitted a plan application titled "Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan for Brookstead Apartments" (the "Plan"). The applicant proposes to construct a four-story 64-unit apartment building, with associated parking. The property is located in the C – Commercial Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has reviewed the Plan and offered comments in his letters dated June 5, 2024, October 1, 2024 and January 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Pocono Township Planning Commission recommended the conditional plan approval of the Plan at a meeting held on January 13, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Pocono Township Board of Commissioners desires to take final action on this Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Pocono Township, County of Monroe, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

That the following requests for modification from the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance are hereby granted:

- 1. SALDO Sections 390-29.K: Community and Financial Impact Analysis. *The applicant shall not be required to submit a community and financial impact analysis.*
- 2. SALDO Section 390-43.A(6)(e)[2][a] Disturbance of Steep Slopes. Applicant shall be permitted to disturb 43.7% of the existing steep slopes.
- 3. SALDO Section 390-55.D.(1)(a) and(c): Street Trees: The applicant is proposing three (3) street trees and to utilize the existing woodlands to satisfy the remaining number of required street trees.
- 4. SALDO Section 390-55.D.(3)(a): Street Trees: The applicant is permitted five (5) of the seven (7) required street trees along S.R. 0611 to be located further than 15 feet from the right-of-way line.
- 5. SALDO Sections 390-55.F.(3)(a)[2]: Buffer Plantings: The existing remaining woodlands are permitted to be utilized to complete the required buffer and to allow buffer plantings outside of the required buffer width.

- 6. SALDO Section 390-55.F.(4)(a)[1]: Trees. The existing remaining woodlands shall be permitted to complete the required screen.
- 7. SALDO Section 390-55.(G): Screening. The trees and shrubs planted in the riparian buffer are permitted to be smaller than requirements of this Section.
- 8. SALDO Section 390-57.C: Wetland Buffers. *The applicant is proposing a portion of the building, retaining wall and grading within the wetlands buffer.*
- 9. SALDO Section 390-59.B: Parking Spaces. *The applicant is proposing 9-foot wide parking spaces.*

That the following requests for modification of the Brodhead and McMichael Creeks Stormwater Management Ordinance are hereby granted:

- 1. SMO Section 365-8.L.: "Roof drains should not be connected to streets, sanitary or storm sewers, or roadside ditches in order to promote overland flow and infiltration/percolation of stormwater." *Applicant proposes to have all roof drains connect to the storm sewer*.
- 2. SMO Section 365-10.I.(6)(b)[1]: Wetlands Buffer. The applicant is proposing a portion of the building, retaining wall and grading within the wetlands buffer.
- 3. SMO Section 365-13.B.: Design Criteria for Rainfall Data. The applicant is proposing to utilize the NOAA Atlas 14 rainfall data as part of the stormwater management analysis to be consistent with the NPDES Application calculations.

That the "Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan for Brookstead Apartments" as shown on the plan prepared by Hanover Engineering Associates, dated April 29, 2024, as revised, be hereby approved with the following conditions and provided the plan is revised as follows, subject to the review and approval of the Township Engineer and/or Township Solicitor:

- 1. The applicant shall comply with all of the conditions and requirements identified in the Township Engineer's letters dated June 5, 2024, October 1, 2024 and January 7, 2025.
- 2. The applicant shall enter into an Improvements Agreement with the Township and provide appropriate security, if deemed necessary by the Township.
- 3. The applicant shall enter into a Maintenance Agreement with the Township and provide appropriate security, if deemed necessary by the Township.
- 4. The applicant shall enter into a Stormwater Management and Maintenance Agreement with the Township, if deemed necessary by the Township.
- 5. The applicant shall pay all necessary fees associated with the Plan, including but not limited to a fee in lieu of dedicating open space in the amount of \$_______, any outstanding

plan account charges and all professional services fees, prior to the recording of the Plan.

- 6. The applicant shall obtain all required permits and approvals from other governmental and regulatory agencies prior to presenting the Plan for signatures.
- 7. The applicant shall provide the requisite number of plans which are signed and notarized by the owner and sealed by the engineer.
- 8. The applicant shall meet all conditions of the plan approval, and Plan shall be recorded within twelve (12) months of Conditional Plan approval, and agrees that if such conditions are not met, the Conditional Plan approval will be considered void.
- 9. The applicant shall accept these conditions in writing within five (5) days of receipt of the Board of Commissioners Resolution, otherwise the Plan is denied.

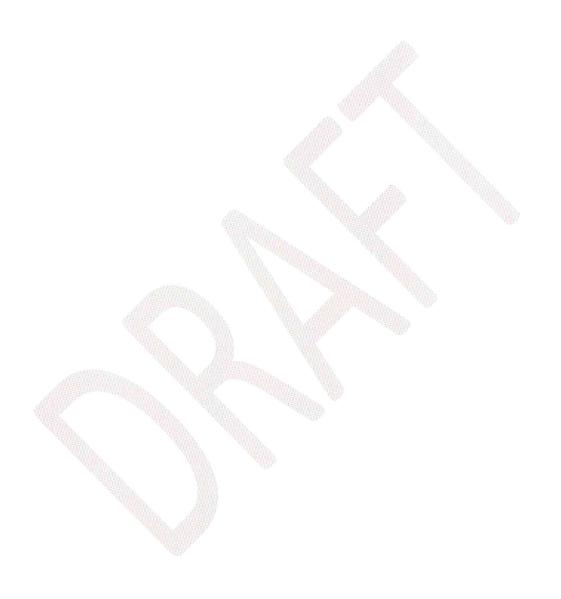

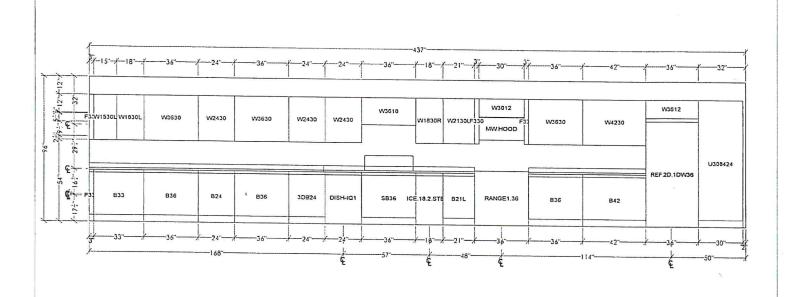

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF POCONO,
COUNTY OF MONROE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
AMENDING THE CODE OF CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF POCONO TOWNSHIP,
PART II, GENERAL LEGISLATION; ADDING A NEW CHAPTER ___, MOBILE
FOOD VENDORS; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF
ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Pocono Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania deem it to be....

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Pocono Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby **ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by virtue of the power vested in the Board of Commissioners by the First-Class Township Code, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Township of Pocono Code of Codified Ordinances; Part II, General Legislation; is hereby amended by adding the following:

"Chapter ____ Mobile Food Vendors

§ **CHAPTER**-. Short Title.

This Chapter shall be known and may be cited as "The Mobile Food Vendor Ordinance of Pocono Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania (the "Township")."

§ CHAPTER-. Scope.

- 1. The provisions of this article shall apply to mobile food vendor operations engaged in the business of cooking, preparing, and/or distributing food or beverage with or without charge from mobile food vendors on or in public, private or restricted spaces.
- 2. This article shall not apply to locations within the Township that have received approval for continued operation of a designated mobile food vendor court, or for events that have received Temporary Use Permits from the Zoning Officer in accordance with Chapter 470, the Township's Zoning Ordinance.

§ CHAPTER-. Definitions

For the purpose of this chapter, certain terms, phrases and words are defined as follows:

- A. Tense, gender and number. Words used in the present tense include the future; words in the masculine gender include the feminine and the neuter; the singular number includes the plural and the plural singular.
- B. General terms. The words "shall," "will" or "must" are always mandatory; the words "should" or "may" are permissive. The words "used for" includes "designed for," "arranged for," "intended for," "maintained for" or "occupied for." The word "building" includes "structure" and shall be construed as if followed by the phrase "or part thereof." The word "person" includes "individual," "profit or nonprofit organization," "partnership," "company," "incorporated association" or other similar entities.
- C. Terms, phrases and words not defined. When terms, phrases or words are not defined, they shall have their ordinarily accepted meaning or such as the context may imply.
- D. Specific terms. Terms or words used herein, unless otherwise expressly stated, shall have the following meanings:

ENFORCEMENT OFFICER The official who is charged with the administration and enforcement of this chapter, or any duly authorized representative.

MOBILE FOOD VENDOR A readily movable licensed motorized vehicle or licensed towed vehicle designed and equipped to prepare, serve, and sell food, drinks (non-alcoholic), frozen dairy, or frozen water-based food products, but which does not include mobile vending carts or mobile retail establishments.

MOBILE VENDING CART A mobile food cart that does not travel under their own power and that are set up on the street that are licensed to sell food to passers-by.

MOBILE RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT A readily movable licensed motorized vehicle or licensed towed vehicle designed and equipped to sell clothing, merchandise, and other similar items for profit or not for profit.

§ CHAPTER-. Mobile Food Vendor Regulations.

1. Location.

- a. A mobile food vendor must be located on private property.
- b. A mobile food vendor and all materials associated with the business shall be removed from the location by 10:00 p.m. each day.
- c. No mobile food vendor shall be located so as to obstruct a public sidewalk, public right-of-way, or clear sight triangle.
- d. Mobile food vendors shall not be located within 50 feet of any residential Zoning District.
- e. Mobile food vendors are permitted only within the Commercial District established by Chapter 470, the Township Zoning Code.

- f. A mobile food vendor selling prepared food shall not be located within 100 feet of an established restaurant during the restaurant's operating hours (determined by measuring from the edge of the mobile food vendor to the foundation of the restaurant) unless permission of the restaurant owner is provided.
- g. A mobile food vendor shall be positioned on improved, designated parking spaces and shall not block: the main entry drive aisle or impact circulation overall; other access to loading areas; or emergency access and fire lanes. The mobile food vendor must also be positioned at least 15 feet away from any fire hydrants and driveway entrances.
- h. A mobile food vendor shall not occupy parking spaces that are designated and required for the existing use(s) on the property. Proof of adequate parking capacity shall be provided to the Enforcement Officer prior to issuance of a mobile food vendor permit. There shall be a minimum of four (4) parking spaces allotted for the mobile food vendor.

2. Hours of Operation.

a. Mobile food vendors are allowed to operate between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. No mobile food vendor shall operate past 9:00 p.m.

3. Noise/Light.

- a. The operation of the mobile food vendor by use of a generator should not be loud enough to be plainly audible at a distance of 100 feet away. Excessive complaints about vehicle or generator noise will be grounds for the Enforcement Officer to require that the mobile food vendor change locations on the site or move to another property.
- b. All portable or temporary lighting shall meet Township Code requirements and may remain on until 10:00 p.m. to allow for the safety of the patrons and employees and to allow for the site to be cleaned properly.

4. Dining Areas.

a. Designed dining areas for patrons of the mobile food vendor are not permitted.

5. Signage.

- a. All signage shall be limited to the surface of the mobile food vendor itself. Only the food products for sale, the name of the business and a price list shall be listed. A Zoning Permit shall be obtained to display alternative signage not affixed to the mobile food vendor.
- b. All signage shall comply with the regulations outlined in Chapter 470, Article VII of the Township Code of Ordinances.

6. Trash.

a. A mobile food vendor shall provide trash and recycling receptacles, and employees shall properly recycle containers and dispose of all trash, refuse and compost that is generate by the patrons in compliance with the Township Code of Ordinances.

§ CHAPTER-. Application for Permit.

- 1. Application requirements. The following are required as part of a mobile food vendor permit application for a mobile food vendor:
 - a. The name of the business and its owner or owners and the mailing address of the business.
 - b. A site plan indicating the location of the proposed mobile food vendor on the property in which they are looking to operate.
 - c. Approval from the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture stating that the mobile food vendor meets all applicable standards prior to operation. must be maintained for the duration of the mobile food vendor permit.
 - d. Proof of access to restroom facilities within 500 feet for the use of the mobile food vendor employees.
 - e. The license plate number for any mobile food vendor proposed to operate within the Township of Pocono.
 - f. Written permission from the owner(s) of the private properties upon which the permit holder will operate and dates/times.
 - g. Proof of adequate parking capacity for the existing use(s) on the property and the mobile food truck vendor.
 - h. The applicant shall pay a licensing fee as established by resolution.
- 2. All mobile food vendor permits shall be in effect as of the date of issuance and shall remain in effect for a period of three months thereafter.
- 3. Every mobile food truck shall post its permit, or a copy of the permit, in a conspicuous place to which the public has access by sight.
- 4. The Enforcement Officer may set a limit on the number of total permits that may be issued per year for the same mobile food vendor and/or mobile food vendor owner. In no case, shall there be more than three (3) permits issued per year to the same mobile food vendor and/or mobile food vendor owner.
 - a. Upon receipt of a mobile food vendor application, the Enforcement Officer shall advise the applicant whether or not the limitation has been met.
- 5. Permit Denial. Within 60 days of the submission of a completed application, the Enforcement Officer shall either issue or deny the application for a mobile food vendor permit.
 - a. If the application is denied in whole or in part, the Enforcement Officer shall state in writing the specific reasons for the denial. Any applicant who has been denied a permit may appeal such denial by submitting a written request for a hearing to the Township within 10 days of denial. Such hearing shall be conducted by the Board of Commissioners within 60 days of receipt of said appeal. The decision resulting therefrom shall be final and subject only to judicial review under Pennsylvania law.

§ CHAPTER -. Transfer of Permit Prohibited.

1. No person holding a permit for a mobile food vendor shall sell, lend, lease or in any manner transfer a mobile food vendor permit.

2. Any unauthorized transfer or attempt to transfer a permit shall automatically void such permit. The unauthorized transfer or attempt to transfer of each permit shall constitute a separate violation.

§ CHAPTER -. Enforcement.

- 1. Appointment; responsibility for enforcement. The Board of Commissioners shall appoint an individual, agency or firm to serve as the Enforcement Officer, who shall be responsible for enforcing the terms of this chapter.
- 2. If it appears to an Enforcement Officer that a violation of this chapter or an issued mobile food vendor permit exists or has occurred, the Enforcement Officer shall provide a written notice of violation to the owner, delivered personally, or by both United States first-class and certified mail. The enforcement notice shall identify the mobile food vendor which is the subject of the violation, enumerate the conditions which constitute the violation, cite the specific sections of this chapter or regulations which are violated, indicate the action required to correct the violation, and provide a time frame (established by the Enforcement Notice based upon the nature of the violation) to correct the violation. The time frame may be immediate; however, in no event shall the time within which to correct the violation exceed seven days.

§ **CHAPTER** -. Violations and Penalties.

- 1. Any violation of this chapter which has not been corrected within the time frame set forth in the notice of violation shall be enforced by action brought before a Magisterial District Judge in the same manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure. Any person, partnership, corporation or other entity who or which violates or permits a violation of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding, pay a fine of not less than \$300 nor more than \$1,000 per violation, plus all court costs and reasonable attorney's fees incurred by the Township in the enforcement proceedings, and/or be imprisoned to the extent allowed by law for the punishment of summary offenses. Each day or portion thereof that a violation exists or continues shall constitute a separate violation. Further, the appropriate Enforcement Officers, agents, or representatives of the Township are hereby authorized to seek equitable relief, including injunction, to enforce compliance with this chapter. All fines, penalties, costs and reasonable attorneys' fees collected for the violation of this chapter shall be paid to the Township for its general use.
- 2. In addition to, but not in limitation of, the provisions of this section, the Enforcement Officer may either revoke, or deny an application to renew, a mobile food vendor permit, for failure to comply with the mobile food vendor permit, the provisions of this chapter or to provide accurate information on the mobile food vendor permit application. The mobile food vendor permit will be revoked, or application to renew denied, for a period of one year for two uncured or repeated violations of this chapter. The Enforcement Officer shall issue, in writing, a notice of revocation or denial to the owner.

§ CHAPTER -. Municipal Liability

1. Pocono Township, and its agents, officials and representatives, shall not under any circumstances be liable or legally responsible for activities or conditions which constitute a public nuisance under the terms of this Chapter. Any liability or damages resulting from activities or conditions constituting a public nuisance are the sole responsibility of the owner of the property, or the person or persons responsible for said activity or condition. The failure to enforce the terms of this Chapter shall not constitute a cause of action against Pocono Township or its agents, officials or representatives.

SECTION 2. REPEALER

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed upon the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of its enactment.
