#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-05**

# A RESOLUTION GRANTING CONDITIONAL APPROVAL OF THE RUNNING LANE, LLC PRELIMINARY/FINAL LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the applicant, Running Lane, LLC, has submitted a preliminary/final land development plan (the "Plan"). The applicant proposes a land development on property located along State Route 0611, approximately 0.7 miles south of the intersection with Lower Swiftwater Road (SR 0314). The existing property (Tract 1) is located with the C Commercial Zoning District and consists of the Pocono Brewing Company with associated parking, stormwater management and on-lot water and sewer services. The existing property is split by SR 0611 and has a total gross area of 5.47 acres, with 0.507 acres located on the eastern side of SR 0611. The proposed land development will occur on Tract 1 and will consist of a 4-story, 90 room hotel with a pool; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 6, 2020, the Pocono Township Board of Commissioners enacted Resolution No. 2020-08 which granted conditional preliminary/final plan approval of the Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-08 required that the applicant meet all conditions of the plan approval and record the Plan within twelve (12) months of the Conditional Plan approval, and if such conditions were not met, the Conditional Plan approval would be considered void; and

**WHEREAS**, the applicant was unable to satisfy the conditions of plan approval and record the Plan within twelve (12) months of the Conditional Plan approval, and is requesting that the Board of Commissioners grant an extension of time to comply with the requirements of Resolution No. 2020-08; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 2021-01, the Board of Commissioners granted the applicant an extension of twelve (12) months to satisfy the conditions of preliminary/final plan approval and record the Plan as set forth in Resolution No. 2020-08; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Pocono Township, County of Monroe, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania the applicant, Running Lane, LLC, shall have a period of twelve (12) months from the date of this Resolution to satisfy the conditions plan approval and record the Plan as set forth in Resolution No. 2020-08.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-06**

RESOLUTION OF TOWNSHIP OF POCONO, MONROE THE COUNTY, ("TOWNSHIP") AUTHORIZING THE ENTRY PENNSYLVANIA INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WHEREIN: 1) THE BROADHEAD CREEK REGIONAL AUTHORITY ("AUTHORITY"), UNDER THE AGREEMENT, WILL PROVIDE UTILITY LOCATION SERVICES PURSUANT TO PA ONE CALL STANDARDS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF POCONO'S SANITARY SEWAGE COLLECTION AND TRANSMISSION SYSTEM; 2) AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT (OR VICE PRESIDENT) TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE TERMS OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND 3) AUTHORIZING PROVISIONS FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, RESOLUTION OF CONFLICTS, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Pocono, Monroe County, Pennsylvania ("Pocono" or the "Township") provides utility services within its township, to wit: sanitary sewage collection and transmission system services which serve portions of Pocono, Hamilton, and Tobyhanna Townships, all in Monroe County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Brodhead Creek Regional Authority ("Authority" or "BCRA"), formerly the Stroudsburg Municipal Authority, was created and exists under the Municipality Authorities Act of General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved May 2, 1945, P.I., 382, as continued by the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved June 19, 2001, P.L. 22 (53 Pa.C.S. Sections 5601, *et. seq.*) (the "Act") as amended, and as evidenced by its Articles of Incorporation, which have been amended to extend the term of its corporate existence to January 1, 2067; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide sanitary sewer collection services, Pocono owns and operates underground sanitary sewage collection and transmission system facilities in the Townships of Tobyhanna, Pocono, Hamilton, Stroud, and the Borough of Stroudsburg as depicted on a plan entitled "Pocono Township Sewer Collection System", dated January 15, 2018, prepared

by Boucher & James, including lead sheet entitled "Pocono Township Force Main Alignment", last revised March 8, 2018, prepared by Boucher & James (hereinafter "Contract Service Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority provides public water supply services through its water distribution system, portions of which are co-extensive to the Township's sewer collection and transmission system; and

WHEREAS, the Authority, as owner of in-ground water distribution system with attendant facilities, is mandated to and does participate in PA ONE CALL Location Services on its own behalf; and

WHEREAS, the Township has requested that the Authority provide PA ONE CALL SYSTEM location and marking services of the Township's underground sanitary sewer collection and transmission system in the Contract Service Area from information and data provided by the Township through its record documents (hereinafter "PA ONE CALL SYSTEM Services"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority agrees that its provision of PA ONE CALL SYSTEM Services for the Township reduces duplication of effort and cost as well as increases efficiencies since the Authority already provides PA ONE CALL SYSTEM Services for its water distribution system located in the Contract Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the Authority finds that by entering into the PA ONE CALL SYSTEM Services Agreement, the Authority has mutually benefitted the customers and citizens of the respective parties.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Board of Commissioners of the Township **HEREBY ADOPTS** the same as follows:

Section 1. PA ONE CALL System Locating and Marking Service Agreement. The Township, through its Board of Commissioners, hereby authorizes the entry into and execution of an intermunicipal governmental agreement with the Authority, to wit: PA ONE CALL System Locating and Marking Service Agreement ("Agreement") substantially in the form attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A". The Township Manager, in consultation with the solicitor for the Township, are authorized to make changes to the Agreement to resolve any outstanding issues with the Authority, after consultation with the Board of Commissioners of the Township.

Agreement. The PA ONE CALL System Locating and Marking Service Agreement authorizes the Authority to provide PA ONE CALL System locating services on behalf of the Township for its underground sanitary sewage collection and transmission system by utilizing data, information, and plans provided by the Township for the fees as set forth in the Agreement. The term of the Agreement is for a period of one (1) year with an automatic annual renewal unless terminated by the parties.

Section 3. Authorization of Further Action. The Township Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all such action, execute, deliver, file and/or record all such documents, publish all notices and otherwise comply with the provisions of this Resolution insofar as the transaction contemplated by this Resolution, in the name and on behalf of the Township.

**Section 4. Severability.** In case any one (1) or more of the provisions contained in this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution

and this Resolution shall be construed and enforced as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

**Section 5.** Repealer. All resolutions and parts of Resolutions heretofore adopted,to the extent that the same are inconsistent n any manner herewith, are hereby repealed.

**Section 6. Further Amendment or Supplement.** The Township may make further amendments to or supplement the Agreement by majority vote of the Board of Commissioners at a public meeting.

**Section 7. Effective Date.** This Resolution is effective immediately with the attached Agreement taking effect upon full execution of the parties.

#### Pocono Township Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting Minutes January 17, 2022 | 7:09 p.m.

The regular meeting of the Pocono Township Board of Commissioners was held on January 17, 2022 and was opened by President Rich Wielebinski at 7:09 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Roll Call:** Jerrod Belvin, present; Ellen Gnandt, absent; Jerry Lastowski, present; Keith Meeker, present; and Rich Wielebinski, present.

<u>In Attendance</u>: Leo DeVito, Township Solicitor via Zoom, Broughal & DeVito; Jon Tresslar, Township Engineer, Boucher & James; Taylor Muñoz, Township Manager; Sergeant Shawn Goucher; and Robert Sargent, Roadmaster.

#### **Announcements**

#### Hearings

Ordinance 2022-01 – Amusement Tax Increase

R. Wielebinski made a motion, seconded by K. Meeker, to open a Public Hearing to consider adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 398, Taxation, Article IV, Amusement Tax, of the Code of Ordinances of Pocono Township to increase the rate of the amusement tax from 3% to 5% for general Township purposes. No discussion. All in favor. Motion carried.

L. DeVito stated that an amendment to the existing amusement tax ordinance requires a public hearing. Once comments are addressed, the hearing can be closed and action can be taken on the proposed amendment.

No public comment.

R. Wielebinski made a motion, seconded by K. Meeker, to close the public hearing. All in favor. Motion carried.

R. Wielebinski made a motion, seconded by J. Belvin, to adopt Ordinance 2021-06 to approve the adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 398, Taxation, Article IV, Amusement Tax, of the Code of Ordinances of Pocono Township to increase the rate of the amusement tax from 3% to 5% for general Township purposes. All in favor. Motion carried.

#### **Presentations**

- Township Municipal Complex Architectural Feasibility Study Design Presentation Joseph Phillips of Phillips & Donovan Architects - Joe Donovan presented a conceptual site design and floor layouts for a proposed new Township complex.
  - R. Wielebinski asked questions regarding the ceiling heights of the public meeting space and whether the building could be designed to support additional office space above the public meeting area if the Township wanted to expand in the future.

- J. Lastowski asked about the square footage of existing administrative office space; current police space versus what is being proposed; and whether the proposed spaces meet the Township's future needs.
- J. Donovan stated the next step would be to get the architectural proposal to the cost estimator to do a more detailed financial breakdown. If the Township moves forward following that process, the Township will need as-builts for public works, go through a schematic design phase, design refinement phase and a construction documents phase.
- J. Lastowski asked about point of no return. J. Donovan stated the construction document phase is the most labor-intensive portion and something the Township would not begin unless they were serious about moving forward with the plan.
- R. Wielebinski asked when plans should be presented to the public. J. Donovan stated next step would be to go through cost estimation and go through further design work. This is an approximate three to four month process.
- J. Belvin asked about seating capacity for public meeting area.
- R. Wielebinski made a motion, seconded by K. Meeker, to proceed with the cost estimating portion of the feasibility study. All in favor. Motion carried.

#### Memorandum of Understanding

The Parties to this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) are Pocono Township and Teamster Local 773 as the representative of all full-time and regular part-time Police Officers, including Sergeants, Corporals, Detectives and Patrolmen, excluding the Chief of Police. The date of this MOU is February 7, 2022 and the purpose is to document the agreement that has been reached between Pocono Township and Teamster Local 773 regarding the Detective Division conducting a trial period of 10-Hour Shifts through December 31, 2022.

- 1. Detectives will be scheduled to work four (4) 10-hour shifts per calendar week, with three consecutive days off per week. The Department shall always have Detective coverage Monday through Friday, and off days shall not occur on a day that requires Court time. Every three (3) months, the detectives will rotate shifts.
- 2. To maximize coverage of the on-duty detectives, all detectives cannot share the same scheduled off days during the regular work week (Monday through Friday). The Chief of Police, or his designee, will have sole discretion to determine the final shift schedule. (Sample schedule attached).
- 3. The Chief of Police, or his designee, shall determine the flexibility of hours and start times for detectives, with recommendations made by the Detective Sergeant based on case load or incident type. The Detective Sergeant may assign incidents to each detective. This shall not preclude the Chief of Police, or his designee, from assigning incidents for investigation as necessary.
- 4. For work in excess of the regularly scheduled 40-hour work period, overtime will be paid at the rate of one-and-one-half (1.5) times the regular hourly Detective rate for each hour worked.
- 5. Detectives will not receive overtime under the Collective Bargaining Agreement when working a 10-hour shift unless they work more than 10 hours.
- 6. All leave time (vacation, holiday, compensatory and personal) will be translated from "days" to "hours." Example: A Detective that receives 15 vacation days annually will have 120 hours of vacation time (15 days x 8 hours = 120 hours).
- 7. After completion of the one (1) year trial period, the parties shall meet to discuss the continuation or termination of the MOU. The final decision on whether to continue or terminate the MOU after the one-year trial period shall be made by the Township in its sole discretion.


