Join us for this practical and encouraging six-session series and discover Biblical insights for witnessing well in our post-Christian world.

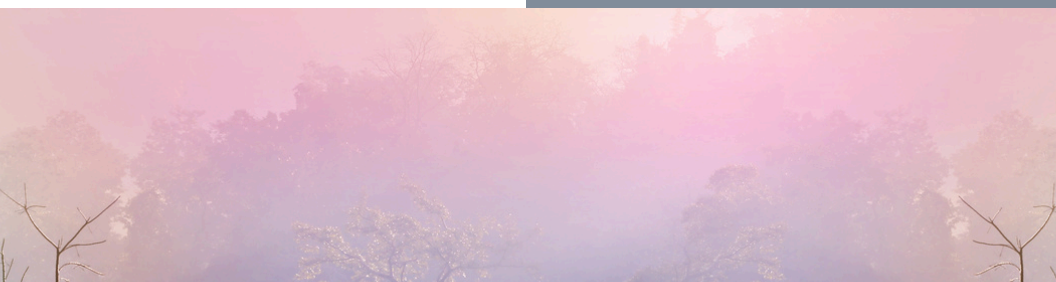

Village Forum Class — February - March 2026

Theme: "The Parables of Jesus."

Dr. Ted L Sauter will explore the Biblical context of the parables and discuss how they continue to speak to us today.

During his ministry, people addressed Jesus as "Rabbi" (or "teacher"). The Gospels state that Jesus frequently taught through the use of parables. Sometimes the parables confused his listeners, and other times enraged them. Always, Jesus' parables challenged people to be more faithful. Why did he not speak "more plainly"? What did Jesus mean when he talked about God's Kingdom? What do these endearing stories mean for us as modern Christians?

Bishop Emerson Colaw initiated the North Naples Church Village Forum in 1997 as a Seasonal opportunity for the congregation to learn, think, discuss, and grow spiritually together by looking at our modern world in the light of the historical Christian faith. Dr. Sauter's leadership this Season is cosponsored by North Naples Church's Adult Discipleship and United Theological Seminary.

There will be five weeks of class (2/22/26, 3/1/26, 3/8/26, 3/15/26, and 3/22/26) in the Village Chapel at 9:30am and repeated at 10:45am.

Dr. Sauter will kick off the Forum by preaching at the three Sunday morning worship services on February 15.

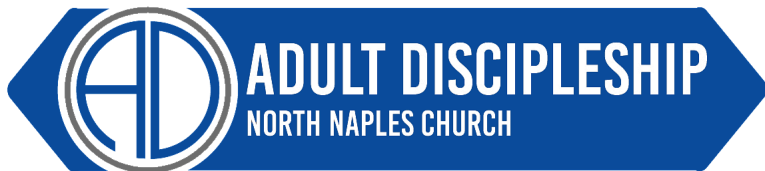
START YOUR OWN GROUP
