

Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No 9
Taxpayer Impact Statement
(Fiscal Year 2026-2027)

This Taxpayer Impact Statement is provided in accordance with Texas Government Code Section 551.043(c)(2), which requires Fort Bend County Emergency Services District No. 9 (the “District”) to post with each notice of a Board of Commissioners meeting at which the Board will discuss or adopt a budget to include the following:

a taxpayer impact statement showing, for the median-valued homestead property, a comparison of the property tax bill in dollars pertaining to the property for the current fiscal year to an estimate of the property tax bill in dollars for the same property for the upcoming fiscal year if:

(A) the proposed budget is adopted; and

(B) for a taxing unit as defined by Section 1.04, Tax Code, other than an independent school district, a balanced budget funded at the no-new-revenue tax rate as calculated under Chapter 26, Tax Code, is adopted¹.

The District will consider a budget for the District’s 2027 fiscal year (“FY”) at the meeting which this Taxpayer Impact Statement is attached to. The FY 2027 budget will be funded in part by the 2026 Property Tax Rate to be adopted by the District. The District intends to adopt its budget on or before September 30, 2026, prior to adopting the 2026 Property Tax Rate.

² The District will consider the proposed FY 2027 Budget and 2026 Tax Rate at the meeting which this Taxpayer Impact Statement is attached to. The proposed budget is based on a 2026 tax rate equal to the No-New-Revenue Tax Rate.
