Megalopolis: The Director's Cut is his debut graphic novel, not a licensed adaptation of his film of the same name. He lives in San Francisco. Chris Ryall was the longtime chief creative officer, editor in chief, and writer for IDW Publishing. Based in San Diego, he is the cofounder of Syzygy Publishing and cowriter of Comic Books 101. He has written many graphic novel adaptations such as Clive Barker's The Great and Secret Show, Stephen King and Joe Hill's Throttle, Harlan Ellison's Phoenix Without Ashes, Shaun of the Dead, George Romero's Land of the Dead, Beowulf, and more. London-based Jacob Phillips is the artist and colorist on Megalopolis; the cocreator, artist, and colorist of That Texas Blood, The Enfield Gang Massacre, and Newburn; and is an Eisner-nominated colorist on books such as Reckless Criminal and Night Fever

Chicago, 1930. Jules Tivoli is a penniless Italian immigrant doing odd jobs to make ends meet. A twist of fate causes him to cross paths with Adam, a kingpin in Chicago's criminal underworld who sees something in Jules that nobody else does—something special. Under Adam's wing, Jules becomes *somebody* and falls in love hard with the man who made him. But after an FBI crackdown,Adam and Jules must flee to New York to escape being caught in the ensuing chaos.

In New York, Jules's Italian heritage gains him access, recognition, and power in the Cosa Nostra crime family. As he becomes more important in a city where Adam can't seem to catch a break, he meets Eufrasio—his handsome, violent, and ambitious new partner who insists that Adam is holding Jules back. But Jules would be nothing without Adam—wouldn't he?

Torn between his past and his future, a sudden betrayal forces Jules to find a way to protect his love and prove his loyalty—if he can even manage to make it out alive.

Anaïs Flogny is an illustrator and cartoonist based in France whose work is inspired by artists like René Gruau, Austin Briggs, Kamome Shirahama, and Cyril Pedrosa. She loves to draw intimate moments, cars, goats, historical fashions from the medieval era to the 1950s, and everything in between. *Smoke gets in Your Eyes* is her debut graphic novel.







In his new graphic biography, legendary cartoonist Bill Griffith, creator of *Zippy the Pinhead*, tells the story of his namesake and great–grandfather, William Henry Jackson, who was one of the first photographers of the American West.


Jackson's photography spurred Americans to move westward, inspiring photographers such as Ansel Adams, and playing a role in the creation of our national parks, including Yellowstone. Using his unique approach to graphic novel biography, which *Kirkus* hails as setting a "standard" for the medium, Griffith explores every aspect of his great–grandfather's life and legacy, which he pulls from family letters, diaries, and anecdotes, primary sources, and the archives of the New York Public Library and the Library of Congress, as well as from the more than 25 books written about Jackson and his work.

Like all of Griffith's biographies, *Photographic Memory* is a thoroughly researched, sharply observant character study written from a place of love, which explores photography in an illustrated medium. Not an easy trick to pull off—unless you are Bill Griffith.

Bill Griffith is the creator of the syndicated daily comic strip *Zippy*. On our ComicArts list, he is the author of *Nobody's Fool: The Life and Times of Schlitzie the Pinhead* and *Three Rocks*, the critically acclaimed, Eisner Award—winning biography of Ernie Bushmiller. Griffith's prolific output has been included in such publications as the *Village Voice*, *National Lampoon*, and *The New Yorker*. Griffith is also credited in *Bartlett* for coining the popular phrase, "Are we having fun yet?" He lives in Hadlyme, Connecticut.




My Life in 24 Frames per Second

The unsung legend of Japanese anime, Rintaro.

Born in 1941 in Tokyo, Rintaro joined the Japanese animated film company Toei Animation in 1958 at the young age of 17. Even in his humble beginnings, when he was involved in putting the finishing touches on the animated film *Legend of the White Serpent*, Rintaro made unfathomable waves for anime as we know it, with Hayao Miyazaki citing it as a core inspiration in becoming an animator and director rather than a manga artist.


In 1960, Rintaro transferred to Mushi Production, an animation studio established and overseen by the "god of manga" Osamu Tezuka himself. He made his directorial debut with the TV anime *Astro Boy* (1963–66) and served as the chief director for the first–ever full–color TV anime in Japan, *Kimba the White Lion*.

Rintaro returned to Toei in 1977, and in 1978 his directorial work on *Space Pirate Captain Harlock* caught the attention of the then–president of Toei Animation, leading to his appointment as the director of the theatrical version of *Galaxy Express 999*.

A unique journey that will take us from postwar Japan to the release of the film *Metropolis* in 2001, *My Life in 24 Frames per Second* is a journey filled with encounters, opportunities, endless nights, jazz, cigarettes, but above all, cinema. Follow Rintaro's memoir as key milestones in the history of Japanese animation are unearthed in insightful clarity.

Rintaro is the pseudonym of Shigeyuki Hayashi, a distinguished anime director and one of the medium's most formative pioneers. As a director, he oversaw *Astro Boy* and the first—ever full—color TV anime *Kimba the White Lion*. His most recent feature length film, *Metropolis*, was one of the first anime films to be submitted for consideration for Best Animated Film at the Academy Awards, and the late film critic Roger Ebert, writing for the *Chicago Sun—Times*, gave *Metropolis* four out of four stars, calling it "one of the best animated films I have ever seen."

A LETTER FROM THE WRITER

I hope this letter finds you well, which, as time goes by, becomes less of a benign pleasantry and more of a genuine concern. Not as it pertains to you personally, as such, but as it pertains to all of us and everyone trapped in the deathbed of American democracy.

I wrote the horror one-shot Thanksgiving to ask a simple question: Who are we? It's a question I've been afraid to answer for some time now as I watch the country I thought I knew devolve into a soulless police state facilitated in equal parts by the apathy or joyful cooperation of fellow citizens.

So "how did this come to be" seems less relevant of a question than "who caused this to be." The short and unsatisfying answer being that we did. So who are the people who sit across the table from us every year at Thanksgiving dinner? Who are the people who want masked gangs to kidnap people off the street in the name of law enforcement? Who are the people who shrug when the state disappears people, including their own family members, into detention camps and overseas super-max prisons, regardless of whether or not they have ever even been convicted of a crime? Who are the people who, for years, told us that we needed a veritable flood of assault rifles and handguns onto our streets to keep us free from government tyranny and then sat back and cracked a beer when the tyranny they warned us of came?

Who allowed, or more accurately, willed this to happen? The people we look at across the Thanksgiving table. The people we smile at as they pass the green beans. Were we always like this? Did the people at the Thanksgiving table somehow gradually become monsters, and we just didn't notice because we were too focused on the candied yams? Or has it always been there, just masked by the fact that we want to imagine the people we love are worthy of it?

This is what the issue *Thanksgiving* is about. It uses the Thanksgiving dinner as a metaphor for how being family blinds us to the monsters at the table and about how easy it is in passing the rolls to become monsters ourselves. And it is, as you've probably guessed, a horror story. Thanksgiving speaks as entertainingly as I dare about something I can no longer ignore. It's a story told around the campfire in which the campfire itself is the killer. But I don't know what else to do at this point. I don't know how we begin to get better without first telling a story about what has gone wrong.

Thank you for taking a chance on this title. It meant a lot to me that AHOY was willing to publish it and that you are willing to read it.
