- Medical Related Transportation Services Arranged by Appointment. This program is intended to provide service for medical appointments to riders who have no other transportation options. Riders with Medicare or riders who are able to pay out of pocket may benefit most from this service.

- No gasoline or flammable liquids
- Pets allowed only in pet crates
- (all trained service animals are allowed)
- No toboggans or sleds
- No furniture or mattresses
- No large pieces of lumber
- No open alcoholic beverages
- No car batteries
- No weapons of any kind
- Weapons recently purchased and in packaging material may be left with the driver, at the driver's discretion.
- Bikes are permitted (in bike racks on front of buses or in wheelchair the downs on the bus, ask driver for assistance)
- Skateboards must be left with the driver upon boarding the bus
- Baby strollers, shopping carts and other items must be kept out of the aisles to avoid creating trip hazards or obstructions which might prevent emergency exiting from the bus.
- For reasons of safety, other items may be prohibited at the discretion of your driver.

About Mountain Line

The Mountain Line Transit Authority was established in 1996 as a merger between the City of Morgantown Transit service and the Monongalia County Transit service.

Mountain Line is governed by a Board of Directors. This seven member board is appointed by the City of Morgantown and the Monongalia County Commission.

The Board typically meets on the third Wednesday of each month. Meetings are held in the Westover Administrative Facility, 420 DuPont Road, and begin at noon. Meetings are open and public comment is welcome.

Holiday Service

All Mountain Line services, except the Grey Line, are closed on these days:

- New Year's Day
- 4th of July
- Thanksgiving
- Memorial Day
- Labor Day
- Christmas Day

Grey Line operates 365 days year-round.

All buses are accessible.

Shuttles start two hours before kickoff, and run every ten minutes. Return shuttles will start at the beginning of the fourth quarter and continue for one hour after the game.

Shuttle buses pick up passengers at the lower entrance to Mountaineer Mall. Cost per passenger is \$1.50 one-way, \$3.00 dollars round-trip. Children 5 and under ride free. Please have correct change ready when boarding the bus. Anyone with a valid WVU ID ride free and valid Tax Pass bus ID holders also ride free. Mobile passes are available in the Token Transit App for \$3.25 round trip. Token Transit allows you to store mobile tickets on your smart device without the need for exact change or change cards.

Mountain Line Transit offers an easy, convenient way to beat the traffic on WVU Football home game days. Park for free at the Mountaineer Mall and take a shuttle to the stadium.

The Grey Line provides 3 trips daily, 7 days weekly, 365 days yearly between Clarksburg, Fairmont, Morgantown, Waynesburg, Washington, Pittsburgh Greyhound and the Pittsburgh International Airport.

- Individual Fare: One Ride/One Way \$0.75 - \$1.00
- Transfers: \$0.75 - \$1.00
- Deviations: \$0.50 - \$1.00
- 15-Ride Pass: \$10.00
- 30-day Pass: Unlimited Rides & Transfers on all local routes (not including Grey Line) -\$35.00
- Monster Pass: \$125 valid on all routes including Grey Line for 30 days
- Senior & Medicare 1/2 Fare (local routes only): \$.35-\$.50/ride, \$.25-\$.50/deviation

- Children 5 and under: Free local routes
- WVU Faculty, Staff & Students: Free local routes with valid WVU I.D.
- High School Student Program: Free local routes with High School I.D.
- Military Appreciation Pass Program: All local routes are free to the riders of this program.

Buy Bus Passes On Your Phone Token Transit Mobile App

A credit or debit card is required to purchase passes. Fares on the Mobile App. include a convenience fee to cover the costs related to the use of the app.

- **Single Ride** - \$0.86
- **2 Ride Pass** - \$1.70
- **15 Ride** - \$11.00
- **30 Day** - \$38.50
- **Monster Pass** - \$145
- **Individual Deviation** - \$0.50

*Once the individual tickets/passes are clicked and activated - they are on a set timer to expire after the allotted time. 10 minutes for Single, 2 Ride, and 15 Ride passes. 30 days for 30 Day and Monster passes. It is important that you only activate a ticket at the time of boarding. Expired tickets will not be reimbursed.

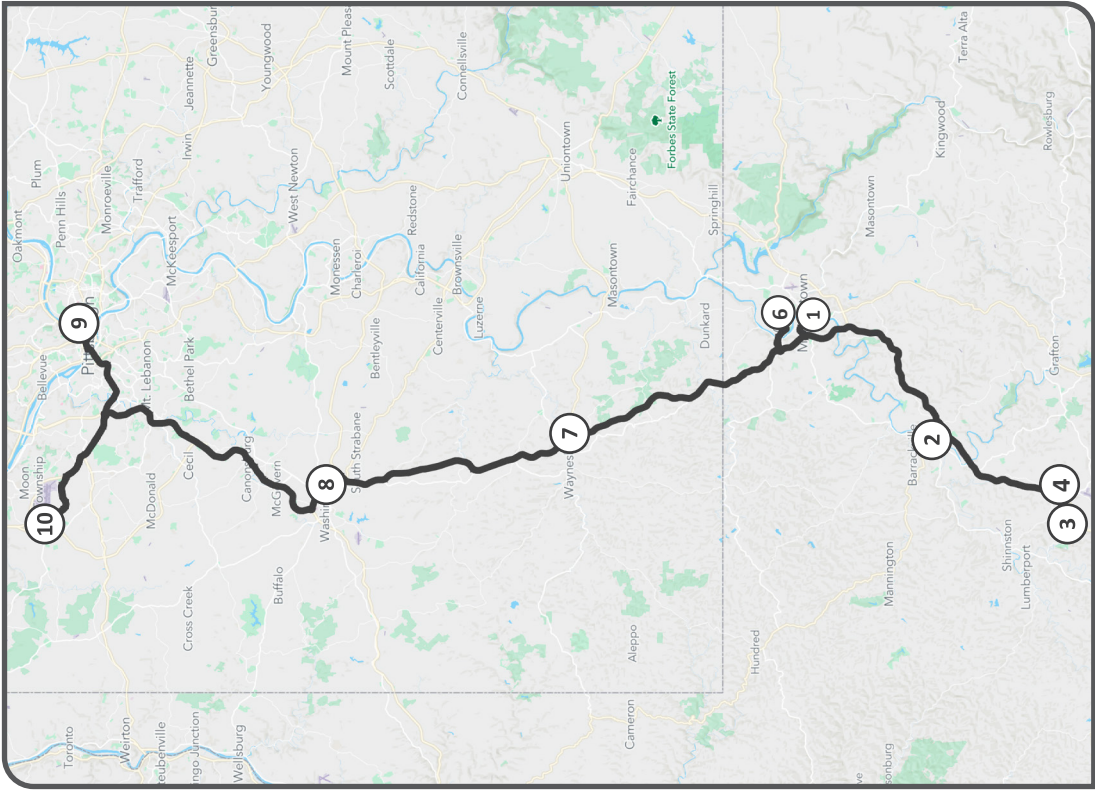

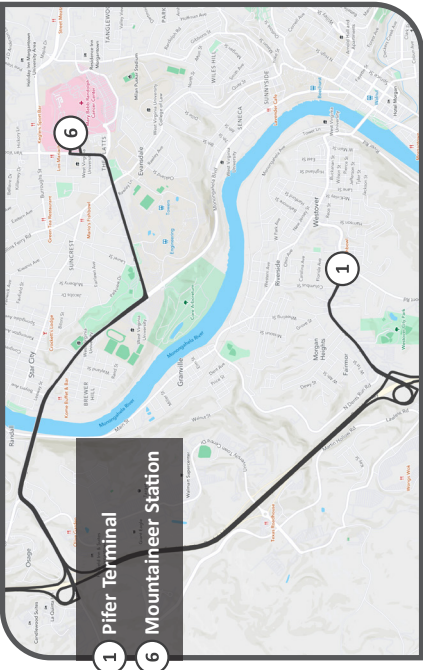

Morgantown Stop Locations



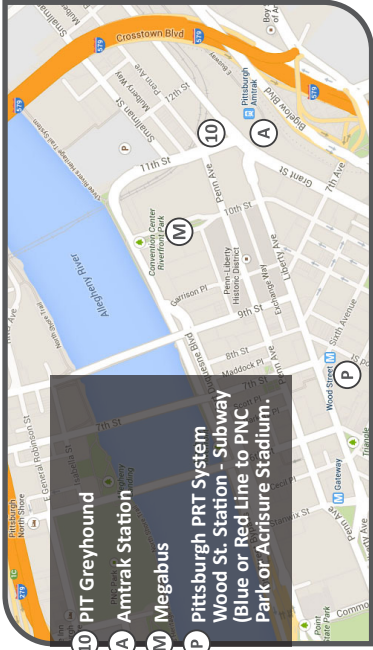

TICKETS

Tickets for Grey Line may be purchased online at ridegreyline.org or by calling 304-296-3869. Passengers may pay cash upon boarding but drivers can not make change and seat preference will be given to those with reservations first.

GREYHOUND INTERLINE

The Grey Line service is interlined with the Greyhound network. You can now visit ridegreyline.org and book your trip anywhere on the network.

GUARANTEED SEATING

It is highly recommended that you make a reservation to ride Grey Line at least 24 hours prior to your trip. Reservations can be made at ridegreyline.org or by calling 304-296-3869

WVU STUDENT SERVICES

During peak travel times, Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break and Spring Break there is added service traveling between Morgantown and Pittsburgh. Look for “WVU Service” when making your reservation.
