The Mountain Line Transit Authority was established in 1996 as a merger between the City of Morgantown Transit service and the Monongalia County Transit service.

Mountain Line is governed by a Board of Directors. This seven member board is appointed by the City of Morgantown and the Monongalia County Commission.

The Board typically meets on the second Wednesday of each month. Meetings are held in the Westover Administrative Facility, 420 DuPont Road, and begin at noon. Meetings are open and public comment is welcome.




