LEVHA: All the ash trees around LEVHA and the other associations will be treated by Sav-A-Tree for borers and bark beetles. They will be injecting these trees the first week of August, then start trimming up some of the dead and hazardous branches in the parking lots and between the buildings. This will go on into August

The pool and lake area have had its share of vandalism for the last couple of months. Report any suspicious activity or issues at the pool, lake, or parking lots to the office immediately. The pool hours are now 6a to 10p (closed 10a-2p Mondays for cleaning).

We've also our share of lewd and outrageous behavior around Lakeside. Police have been called numerous times and we actually made the local news with someone being tazed and arrested near the end of Lakeside Ct. Landlords need to do a thorough background and credit check on any new tenants, and be choosey. Tenant registration is a must and if we don't receive one, there could be a \$250 fine for not having up-to-date tenant registration on file. Property Managers need to follow this rule also.

APPLERIDGE: We had our Board meeting on the 22nd of July (2nd Quarter review) and went over the landscaping work completed this quarter and what still needs to be completed on the grounds and building maintenance. We'll be finishing up painting and maintenance this month and into September, so we can keep up on our regular

maintenance program we have set up. We'll be painting the storage door and trim, west side of 700 building, and touch up on the 200 & 300 buildings.

We will also have Sav-A-Tree over to inject all the ash trees for borers and bark beetles. The city of Grand Jct. covers \$500 of this cost, and we hope that the treatment will last a couple of years.

There are a couple of owners fences that need maintenance and be painted. We have sent out letters to the owners already, so if you received a letter, please get this work done within 30 days. Let's keep Appleridge COA looking good!

TERRACE: We are getting to many owners/tenants dropping off large items (beds, desks, bed frames, mirrors, etc.) leaving them around the trash cans. Please don't leave these items at the trash bins....this is illegal and you will be fined if we catch you. We have to pay someone to pick up this trash and take it to the dump. We are going to put cameras to watch these areas and will start monitoring who is dropping off these large items. Please be respectful and don't do this!

Bagged trash needs to be taken to the dumpsters immediately and not left on the stoop or on the back patio. We are working with the roofers and insurance to get a new roof on Grenada. Work is to start in September.

Beginning September 1, propane tanks on balconies will be limited to 2.5 lbs. or smaller for safety reasons. Your Board of Directors should have 3-6 members. One must be an owner and current on all fees to serve. Currently, we only have two members. If anyone is interested, please let Brent know in the office. We meet on the third Thursday of the month.
