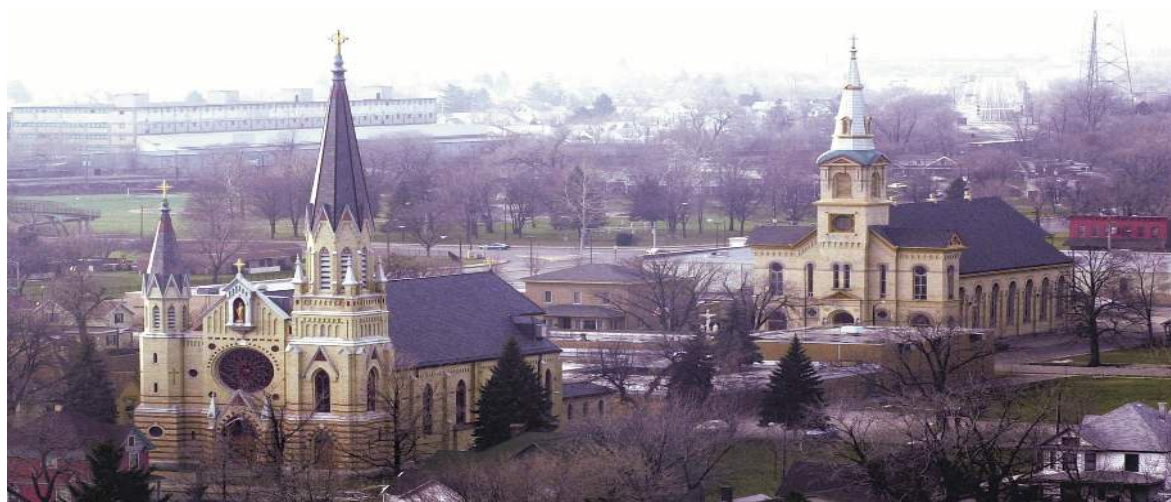

Parish Mission Statement

In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

From the Desk of Fr. Reginald Wolford, OP

Dear Friends,

As you have seen in this space, I have been periodically providing introductions to the friars living in community here at St. Patrick and St. Hedwig. Below is that of Br. John Steilberg, whom you have often seen greeting you after masses, when he is not in Chicago or Puerto Rico or anywhere else his duties take him. Did you know that not all of our members get ordained? Some remain as brothers, living our life of prayer, study, and community and serving our mission in many other ways. Some of the great saints of our order, like St. Martin de Porres and St. Juan Macias, were from this group.

Brother John is a member of the Province of St. Albert the Great (Central United States). I currently serve as the Syndic (Treasurer / Financial Administrator) for the Central Province whose offices are in Chicago. I also serve as what is called the Promoter for the Dominican laity of the province. The laity are the 600 or so members of the Order of Preachers located throughout the Province (Midwest USA and Puerto Rico) who become formally part of the Order as lay people, committing themselves to the Dominican charism and mission while structuring their life by an approved Rule. I am a non-ordained member of the Order of Preachers referred to as cooperator brothers. I am originally from Louisville, KY. My previous areas of ministry and interests include: non-profit management and leadership particularly in Catholic organizations and educational institutions, solutions to the problem of poverty, direct service to those in need, the practice of Catholic charity, leadership in the Catholic Church, and theology and its practical applications.
