In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

### From the Desk of Fr. Reginald Wolford, OP

“Bring gifts and enter his courts” (Ps. 96:8).

Dear Friends,

You may have noticed that, at Christmas time, we brought back the practice of having parishioners carry the gifts of bread and wine up to the altar during the Offertory at mass. This is a simple gesture, but it has a deep meaning that I would like to reflect on with you today. As you can see, the bread and wine are brought up at the same time as the collection. This should get us thinking, not only about keeping the lights on, but also about what we owe in return for God's generosity, and how He can transform our gifts. Stop and think about all the work that went into producing the bread and wine that will become the Body and Blood of Christ - the work of the farmers, those who feed them, those who transport their goods. This helps us to understand that all of our good human activities, by God's blessing, can have an eternal significance. Next time you see the gifts being brought up at Mass, I would like to invite you to stop and think about the gifts that you can offer to the Lord in your everyday life.
