

As you know, if we fall short of our assessment, the remainder will have to come out of general parish funds, which we frankly cannot afford; on the other hand, if we go over our assessment, we will be able to allocate the extra funds to things like our sound system and building improvements, among other things. With God's help and your responsible generosity, I trust that we will make our goal this year.
