**From the Desk of Fr. Reginald Wolford, OP**

Dear Friends,

As we continue our Synod process with another prayer meeting after masses this weekend, I would like to share some reflections on the remaining themes of Spiritual and Liturgical Life, Vocations, and Outreach.

Spiritual and Liturgical Life pertains to the relationship that God invites us to. We should all be spending time every day in personal prayer. Like with a friend or a spouse, you would not be building much of a relationship if you didn't spend time together. Liturgical Life pertains to the public prayer of the Church - the Mass, as well as the other sacraments and ceremonies that we celebrate. The Church has been entrusted with the care of these times of public prayer to help us enter into the mysteries.

Vocations are a matter of God's call. By virtue of our baptism, we are all called to holiness, while some are called to pursue holiness in the priesthood and/or in a religious community. When the other aspects of the faith are strong, it will help many young men and women to be attracted to the beauty of these ways of life.

Finally, our faith should result in a greater love of our neighbor. When we are convinced of the Lord's great love and care for us, that can lead to greater compassion and generosity for those who are in need around us.

I hope we can see how none of these themes are isolated, but they all strengthen each other and form a whole in our practice of the Faith. I would like to invite you to make a point of coming to the Parish Consultation after the 10:30 mass on March 22nd, to share your thoughts and help the leaders of the Church make informed decisions for the future.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, fasting is required of those from the age of 18 through 59 inclusive; one full meal is permitted per day, two smaller meals may be taken which together would not equal a full meal. No other food may be taken. On Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent, abstinence from meat is binding on those aged 14 and above.


