

Current Law for Fasting and Abstinence:

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday Fasting is required of those from the age of 18 until 59; one full meal is permitted per day, two smaller meals may be taken which together would not equal a full meal. No other food may be taken. Abstinence from meat is binding on those aged 14 and above. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. Exemption is allowed for pregnant women and those who need regular meals for medical reasons.


