On this Divine Mercy Sunday, also known as the 2nd Sunday of Easter, we revel in the last week of celebration of the Resurrection of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! 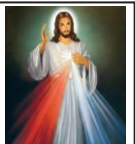
