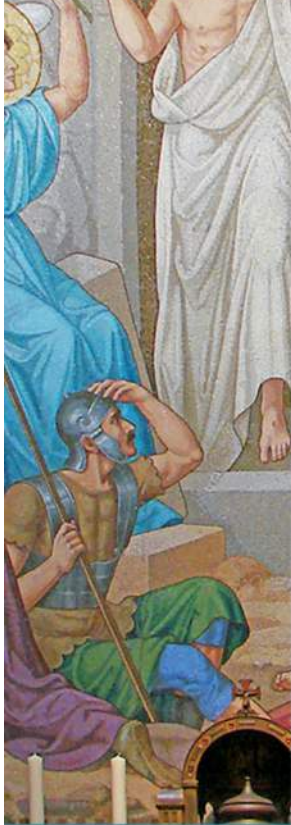

Parish Mission Statement

In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

Dear Friends,

If you were at the 10:30am Mass last Sunday, you heard Andrew Goldstein invite you to consider joining the choir that he is forming for that Mass. I would like to reinforce that invitation.

I remember many years ago, at one of my first experiences of a Catholic Mass, listening to those voices that sounded like they came from another world. It did not sound like any other music I had ever heard on the radio or in those early days of MTV! - it was truly the sound of prayer. I later learned that what I was hearing was Gregorian Chant, and that it was part of the musical tradition that has developed in the Church over two millennia. The Church in her documents has repeatedly reaffirmed the importance of singing in the liturgy - it is not simply a matter of taste, but rather is a way of training our hearts to give God due reverence. We are blessed to be allowed to take part in the praise of God through music.

It comes as no surprise, then, that a church choir is often a place of deep prayer and fellowship. (I would join the choir myself, if I didn't have other duties on Sunday mornings.) Please consider joining the 10:30 choir, and be on the lookout for future opportunities at our other masses.
