In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

The Sacrament of the Sick

Dear Friends,


As you may know, I offered the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick after the 10:30 mass on Divine Mercy Sunday. As it is a sacrament for the sick, it is often celebrated in homes or in hospitals, so it was a blessed occasion to offer it in the church, where much of the community could be present to pray for our sick parishioners, and to remember that sacrament and its importance.

The Anointing of the Sick is, along with Reconciliation, one of the Sacraments of Healing. Anyone who is in any danger of death from illness or injury can receive it (it doesn't have to be *extreme* danger of death). You can receive it multiple times if there is a new illness, or if the same illness has gotten worse.

Jesus took on our weakness, and our susceptibility to death, when he became one of us. This Sacrament consecrates our weakness to Him and helps to cleanse us of the remains of sin. If possible, the sick person should receive Reconciliation and Holy Communion as well; however, if the person is unconscious or unable to speak or eat, the Anointing can still be done.

If you or a loved one need to receive Anointing, please contact me by email or through the church office, and I will gladly find a time to come; or, in an emergency, I will get there ASAP.

God bless you, and remember to pray for our beloved sick,
