



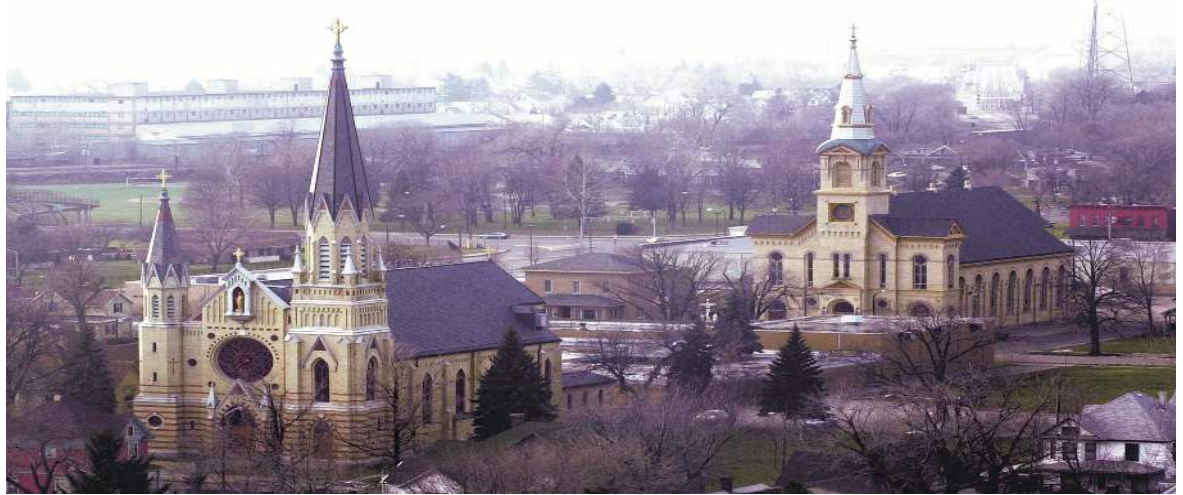

### Parish Mission Statement

In fidelity to Jesus Christ, in 1858 Irish and German immigrants founded St. Patrick Parish—the Mother Parish of South Bend—and in 1877 Polish immigrants founded St. Hedwig Parish—the Mother Parish of the Polish Community of South Bend. Saint Patrick Parish and Saint Hedwig Parish combined as one parish with two historic churches on August 22, 2024. The Parish sets to the western edge of Downtown South Bend in the West Washington National Historic District. As a faith community, we seek to bring the gifts of these two traditions together as one in the Roman Catholic Rite—to proclaim the Gospel and to celebrate the Eucharist in order to strengthen our resolve and to seek to live the Gospel message and so enrich our lives and the lives of others, our neighborhood, and our workplaces.

**From the Desk of Fr. Reginald Wolford, OP**

Dear Friends,

As we celebrate this Trinity Sunday, we must rejoice with wonder at God's generosity in revealing to us the secret of His inner life as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. With this revelation, He has given an incredible dignity to us mere human creatures. He created us out of nothing, and formed us from the dust of the earth, and yet He invites us into an intimate relationship with Himself. This should help us to affirm the dignity of ourselves and our neighbors as children of God.

It is fitting then that the Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, has this week given us his first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas*, to help us reflect on the constancy of our dignity in the face of changing circumstances. We should always remember that the essential truths of our faith and morals remain the same, even as we must discern how they apply to new technologies. A big concern of the Holy Father is the prevalence of Artificial Intelligence (AI) these days. As impressive and even useful as such technology can be, it can never be a substitute for real human thought and love.

This is a long document, (one that I have not been able to study fully as yet) and there are many resources out there to help you understand it. Please pray that it has the good effect in our world that the Pope intends.
